5. Volleyball

We will vote on the volleyball rule change at the April meeting.

All Saints will host an Invitational Pre-Season Volleyball tournament. The top four teams from the 7th and 8th grade league will be invited to participate in this two day tournament. The tournament will be August 27 and 28. If your team qualifies, you will be notified.

Try to have your volleyball players sign up in May. This will allow your school to be prepared for any early tournaments.

6. Basketball

The state tournament and the city tournament went well. Many thanks to Steve, Mike and Gary for another successful basketball season!!

If you have students that played on another school's team and did not get a trophy, please let Steve know. He can get extra trophies.

There were 10 fewer teams than last year participating in the tournament. It might be good to invite more Catholic school teams to enter the tournament next year. We can also arrange the girls' schedule to accommodate outside volleyball games and tournaments and hopefully have more girls' teams participate.

We also discussed having the second and third graders end their season in January. We would continue to have them play ten games, but they might be playing twice on one day in December and January.

In the future we need to make sure that all the referees for the state tournament games know the CGSAA rules and are able to fully participate in running the court.

7. Track

There was a track meeting on March 11. Practice schedules at the McGuinness track were handed out.

Johnny is contacting the track coordinators about the schedule and the changes in the meet.

There will no longer be a standing broad jump, a softball throw or a 50 meter dash for seventh and eighth grade boys and girls.

There is a new gate code at Bishop McGuinness track. Gary will be sending it to the reps.
