## Message from our President

Thank you for your interest in the North Pittsburgh Wildcats. 2018-19 turned out to be a terrific year for the association.

The association saw **strong growth** in 2018-2019, with increased participation in our Learn-to-Play, 8u ADM, 14u In-house, and travel programs.

Our travel teams represented us well in PAHL during the regular season and in the playoffs, and also in regional tournaments and independent competition. Throughout the season, our players made significant improvement with their hockey skills. Additionally, they also gained good life skills such as teamwork, perseverance, and sportsmanship as the season progressed.

For 2019-2020, NPYHA will continue to offer hockey programs for children of all ages and skill levels. We will feature a travel hockey program that will compete regionally in PAHL with teams at the AA, A Major, A Minor, and B levels. We will offer an in-house league for local enthusiasts, and will continue to offer development programming to introduce children to our great game.

This document describes our travel hockey programming for the upcoming season. Due to the growth and interest in hockey over the recent years, we are limited in the number of travel players we can accept. To determine teams, we conduct a tryout process to measure player talents and to group kids of similar skill. All players who attend tryouts are scored on their fundamental skills and game situations. Each player will be graded by several different evaluators. The evaluators will once again be carefully selected from the local hockey community for their hockey development experience and knowledge. They include current Wildcats coaches, past coaches, and independent coaches from other amateur, high school, junior, college, and professional programs. Player scores are used to make placements onto travel teams.

The tryout process runs over a period of several days for each age level to provide a fair and equitable experience for all participants who attend.

All of the key information you need to prepare for this year's tryout process is contained in this document. Please read it entirely before registering. We look forward to another great hockey season in 2019-2020.

# Travel Hockey Programming

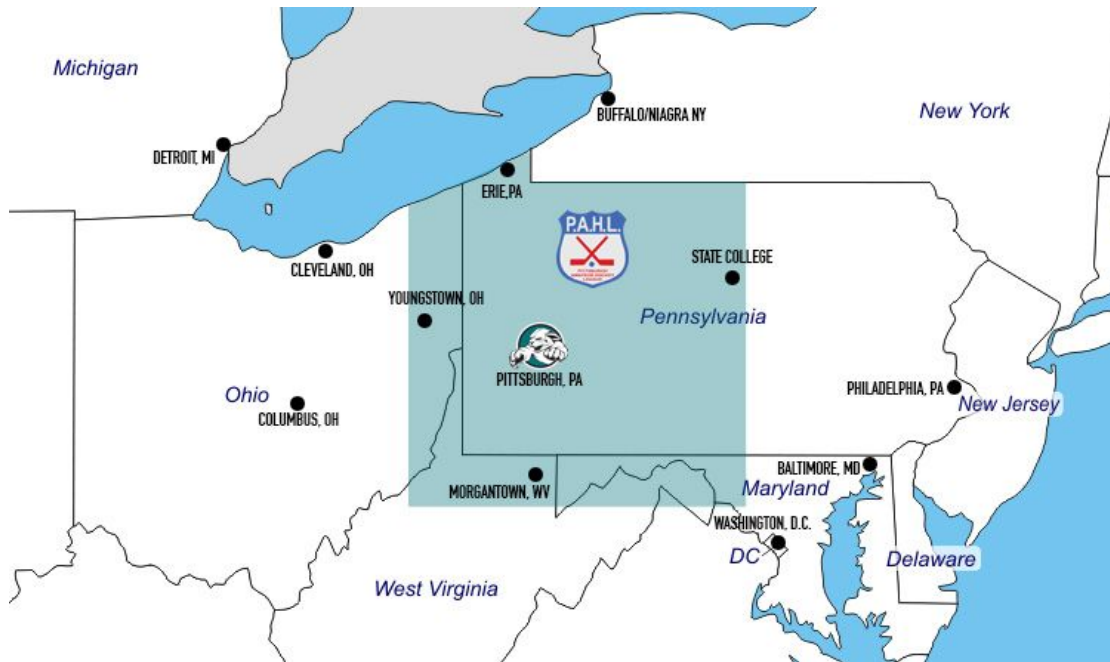
The North Pittsburgh Youth Hockey Association (NPYHA) offers competitive hockey programming for children in the Pittsburgh area. The following table summarizes the anticipated travel team programming offered by the association for the 2019-2020 season. The season runs from mid-August through the end of March. League play runs from October through the first week of March.

## Travel Commitment



NPYHA teams will typically compete in the Pittsburgh Amateur Hockey League (PAHL). The league is made up of youth hockey associations in and around the Western PA region. League travel will be required on weekends. League travel may be required as far north as Erie, as far east as State College, as far south as Morgantown WV, and as far west as Youngstown, OH. See the shaded region above.

NPYHA travel teams also participate in local and out-of-town tournaments, and some teams may schedule independent games or home-and-home series against teams of similar skill in the Eastern and Central US. Travel and overnight stays may be required outside the Western PA region to cities such as Cleveland, Columbus, Detroit, Buffalo, Rochester, Philadelphia, and Washington DC. Travel outside the US to Canada may also be required.

A select number of NPYHA teams may request to opt out of PAHL and play an independent schedule. Teams interested in playing outside of PAHL must have 100% parental backing and must present their case to the NPYHA Vice President and Director of Travel Hockey for consideration by June 30. The application will subsequently be evaluated by the NPYHA Board of Directors.

## Team Composition and Alignment

NPYHA expects to field several teams at each age group (10u-16u/18u). **We aim to place 15 skaters and 2 goalies on each team. At 14u, 16u, and 18u, we may place additional skaters on teams. If we are unable to place 15 skaters and 2 goalies on a team, we will make efforts over the summer and fall to identify and add players after tryouts to reach these numbers.**

For competitive purposes, PAHL groups local teams into divisions by skill level. NPYHA teams are selected to PAHL divisions via the PAHL placement process using player data and the results of a few preseason matches. Placement of our teams will be determined by PAHL and there is no guarantee of any NPYHA team (or teams from other PAHL associations) playing in the top division of its age group in PAHL.

The top 14u team, the top 16u team, and the top 18u team will register as Tier II National Bound teams and are expected to compete in Mid-American District Championships and USA Hockey National Championships.

Wildcats teams traditionally practice on weeknights and have additional practices and games on weekends. Weeknight practices for many teams will start as early as 5:00 PM on weeknights. Weekend practices may start any time between 6:00 AM and 8:20 PM.

**Total Games** played in the season is dependent on the team direction as set by the team Head Coach. Some higher-end teams will seek to add additional games and scrimmages against similarly skilled opponents from outside our region. These teams may also play in additional tournaments, invitationals, and national competitions such as the International Silver Stick tournament series. All additional games are funded by the team through its Team Fee pool or fundraising. Higher-end teams may finish the season with 50-55 games played.

## Remarks on Birth Year Teams

Due to recent PAHL re-alignment at the 14u level, North Pittsburgh will re-introduce birth year teams at 14u and up for **ONE** team only. This will result in one 13u (2006 birth year - expected to play in PAHL 14u AA Minor), one 14u (expected to play in PAHL AA Major), one 15u (2004 birth year - expected to play in PAHL AA or A Major Black), and one 16u AA team (expected to play PAHL 16u AA). All other 16u and 14u teams will be comprised of mixed birth years with players placed on teams according to similar skills.

At 10u and 12u, North Pittsburgh will assign players to teams based on similar skill rather than similar age. This ensures that all players will have the most competitive peer group for practice, and ensures that all teams will have the most homogeneous skillset possible for league placement and game play. Birth year teams at 12u and 10u are possible at North Pittsburgh, but they are not formed by design. For example, the top team in each age group is typically made up of second-year players, and therefore often qualifies as a birth year team.

## Professional Hockey Instruction

NPYHA has historically provided professional power skating instruction, skill development, and goaltending instruction to its travel players. For the past three seasons, NPYHA has brought in professionals such as **Cliff Loya of National Elite Hockey** for skating and skill development and **Ed Newill** for goaltending development. North Pittsburgh plans to use the services of these professional instructors again for the 2019-2020 season pending their availability. These services are offered to our 10u, 12u, 14u (Teams 3 and lower), and 14u-19u Girls teams.

## Financial Commitment and Fee Descriptions

Players trying out for a travel team will need to pay a **Tryout Fee** to attend tryouts. Your tryout fee will be collected online at the time of registration. The tryout fee is **NOT** applied to your organizational fee if you make a team. **All prior season balances must be paid in full before a player may be permitted to try out.**

**At tryouts we will collect from you a Commitment Fee in the form of a check** to secure your player's spot on a travel team if he/she makes a team. **Families must make their Commitment Fee payment to North Pittsburgh in order to go on the ice at tryouts.** Your Commitment Fee serves as a **down payment on your Organizational Fee**. If you decline your placement on a team, your commitment fee check will be destroyed. The deadline to decline your placement is 72 hours from the time of our team announcements.

If your child is assigned a roster spot on any of the top teams within each group, your commitment fee will be cashed.

By paying the commitment fee, you agree to have your player play at North Pittsburgh in the upcoming season. You are also making a promise to North Pittsburgh to pay your Organization Fee in full for the upcoming season. **Should a player pay the \$400 commitment fee, accept a placement but leave NPYHA after the commitment fee deadline, the \$400 will not be refunded.**

**Organizational Fees** cover each player's ice time for practices, pre-season games, and league games, and professional services for games including referees and emergency medical technicians. The fees listed above are approximate, and will be finalized over the summer after the final rosters are determined and the annual budget is approved. The Organizational Fee is adjusted based on the number of teams and number of players registered per age group level and the amount of planned practice ice that the team will receive. Organizational Fees can be paid up front or on a 4-payment schedule. Failure to make regular payments will result in ice privileges being suspended until account is in good standing.

**New for 2019-2020:** North Pittsburgh expects to increase the use of non-parent coaches for some of its higher end teams. This was well received by membership in recent years. If your player is assigned to a team with a non-parent coach, your Organization Fee

will be increased approximately \$350 for 16u and younger. The 18u team may also opt for a non-parent coach. Pricing will be adjusted upward if this option is taken.

**Team Fees** are used to form a pool of funds to cover team-specific expenses, such as tournament fees, extra ice slots, professional services for the team, and team social activities. Team Fees are **mandatory** at North Pittsburgh, and you may not opt out of the team fee if your player cannot attend any team event. The amounts listed above are approximate and will be finalized over the summer by your team head coach and team manager, and payable to your team manager no later than October 1.

**Uniform Costs** are approximate. They are provided as a guideline for players who have not previously owned a Wildcats travel uniform. The required uniform for NPYHA is: 1 home game jersey, 1 away game jersey, 1 black pant shell, 1 pair home socks, and 1 pair away socks. Girls 10u/12u will use the In-house program uniforms which are different than our traditional travel uniforms. Uniform costs do not include warm-up suits or other NPYHA-branded apparel or equipment. You will receive more uniform details and ordering information immediately after making a team.

## 18u Game Only

For 2019-2020, our 18u team will operate as a "Game Only" format. The teams will receive a limited number of practices in the pre-season (August - September) and before the post-season (February or early March). There will be no or very few weeknight practices. The lighter practice schedule is meant to balance the demands on the youth at this age who are likely participating in their high school hockey program as well as with the Wildcats. Since the high school and amateur seasons coincide, we believe a lighter practice schedule would allow more players to continue playing amateur hockey.

## Girls Only Teams

For the 2019-2020 Season, PAHL expects to have Girls divisions at 12u, 14u, and 19u. Historically, North Pittsburgh has been able to field teams at these age classes.

### 10u and 12u Girls Teams

North Pittsburgh will attempt to form at least one team at 12u and maybe a second team at 12u if there is sufficient interest within the membership. If we can form two teams, the first team may operate as a full travel team, with weeknight and weekend practices. The second team may operate in conjunction with our In-house program and may receive additional practices on the weekends as ice time allows.

Girls from our In-house program and our travel program are welcome to participate on these teams. NPYHA will make efforts to keep girls playing together and will plan to play an independent schedule in case PAHL divisions do not materialize.

### 14u, 16u, and 19u Girls Teams

North Pittsburgh will make every attempt to form two girls travel teams in 2018-2019. We traditionally have a 14u and a 19u team. These teams will operate as traditional travel teams and will have weeknight practices, weekend practices, and games. North Pittsburgh will participate in PAHL if there are Girls divisions. If PAHL is unable to create a Girls division, our girls teams will play an independent schedule against teams within our geographic region.

# Registration Process

## Register with USA Hockey

You must have a 2019-2020 USA Hockey registration number to register for NPYHA tryouts. Registration for USA Hockey registration opens **April 1 this year**. Obtain your registration number online at [www.usahockeyregistration.com](http://www.usahockeyregistration.com).

## Register for an NPYHA Program

Registration is expected to open online on or around **April 1 this season**. With your 2019-2020 USA Hockey registration number handy, go to the NPYHA web site at [www.wildcatshockey.net](http://www.wildcatshockey.net) and go to **Tryouts > Registration**. Click on the appropriate link to register.

Our registration system is provided by SportEngine. You must have a SportEngine ID and password to access our registration system. If you are a returning player, you will need to retrieve your ID and password from last year. If you are new to NPYHA, you may need to create a new ID and password.

Tryout fees will be collected electronically during registration.

NPYHA will require the following forms to be acknowledged online during your tryout registration process.

- NPYHA Player Code of Conduct Form
- NPYHA Parent Code of Conduct Awareness Form

NPYHA will also be collecting health insurance data on all players at registration, with your acknowledgement that NPYHA has your consent to treat your player for injuries sustained during our events and activities.

# The Tryout Process

## What Time Is My Tryout?

Skaters are grouped alphabetically by last name for the first night of tryouts. Tryout times and last-name groupings will be posted on our home page at [www.wildcatshockey.net](http://www.wildcatshockey.net) the night before the first day of tryouts.

After the first night, players are re-grouped each night for the remainder of tryouts. **You must check the NPYHA website each evening during tryouts to determine your next tryout time.** Ice slot assignments will be posted by tryout number on our home page at [www.wildcatshockey.net](http://www.wildcatshockey.net).

Please note: the tryout process is several days long, however, the process may not require all days as listed in this newsletter, and may be concluded sooner.

## Tryouts Day 1 Procedures

There will be a sign-in table at the front of the rink, where we will record attendance, collect commitment fee checks, and assign each player a tryout number. **Players will not be allowed on the ice without commitment fee check - NO EXCEPTIONS.** The tryout number is required to be displayed on the front and back of each player's jersey on every day of the tryout process.



## Preparing for the Ice

Arrive at the rink for your designated tryout in plenty of time to check in and change. Bring two jerseys to every session - one dark and one white. Please do not wear bright colored jerseys such as red, green, orange, etc. Stick with dark and white. These jerseys should be **unmarked**. No names and no emblems of PAHL, PIHL, or AAA teams are permitted at tryouts. Please do not wear identifying pants shells and socks for tryouts.

Affix your tryout pin-on number to both the front and back of your jersey. You will need to keep your pin-on numbers for all days of tryout process. Please note that we may assign you a jersey color (dark or white) during tryouts and the assigned color may change during tryouts.

## Tryout Absences

If a player is going to miss all or part of the tryout process due to injury, illness or a school-related conflict, **you must still register and pay your tryout fee. We will make every effort to place the player based on whatever information we have on file.**

You must also notify Director of Travel Hockey Daryl Dolan ([directorofhockey@wildcatshockey.net](mailto:directorofhockey@wildcatshockey.net)) and Registrar Neal Cerqua ([registrar@wildcatshockey.net](mailto:registrar@wildcatshockey.net)) as soon as possible. We will do our best to accommodate a player's absence within the tryout process.

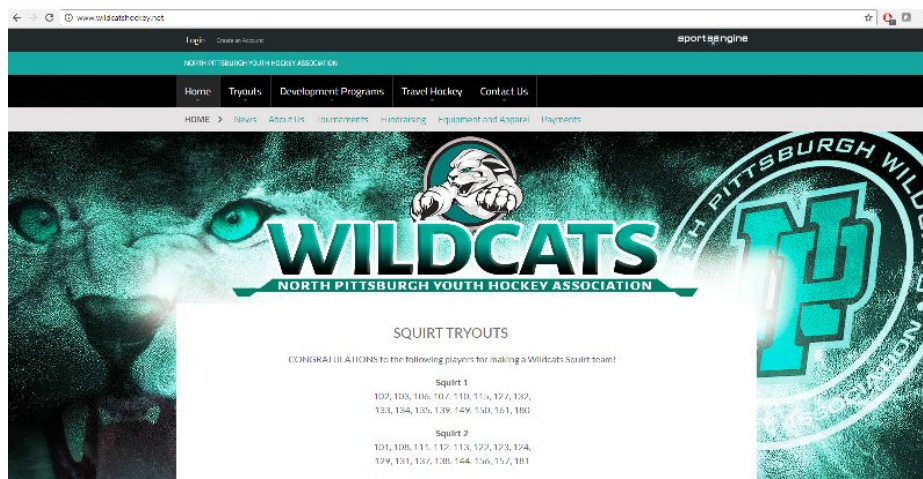

## Post-Tryouts: What Happens Next?

The following day after tryouts, team assignments will be posted to our website at [www.wildcatshockey.net](http://www.wildcatshockey.net). No names will be posted to the web site.



Players will be identified by their tryout number only. Coaches will be in touch shortly after tryouts are completed and teams are assigned. Players that make a travel team are required to make a decision to accept or decline their roster spot within 72 hours of final results posted on the website. The head coach or tryout coordinator will make every effort to contact each family in a timely manner. However, please understand that it is the player's responsibility to decline the roster spot. **If you do not email the coach or Director of Hockey declining your spot, we will assume that you are accepting your offer and we will cash your commitment fee check.** The deadline to decline your roster spot is 72 hours from the time of our team announcements.

# Discounts and Refunds Policy

## Discounts (full travel teams only)

The following discounts are available to NPYHA players.

- Multi-player families receive: 10% discount for their second player, 15% for third player, 20% for all additional players.
- Double-rostered girls are eligible for multi-family discount amount for registering on multiple teams.
- Early payment discount of \$75 per full travel team player or \$50 for midgets will be applied if your total organizational fees are paid in full by August 1.

## Fundraising

- NPYHA offers two candy sales per season to help defray the cost of your Organization Fee. Families may sell items from Betsy Ann Chocolates and retain a sizeable portion of their sales as proceeds toward your fees.
- For the 2019-2020 season, you may apply the proceeds of last season's (2018-2019) Spring/Easter sales and the proceeds of your Winter/Christmas 2019-2020 sales to your Organization Fee.
- Note: if you are planning to use the NPYHA candy fundraiser proceeds to help with your NPYHA fees, you should not pay your organizational fee in full. IRS regulations prohibit us from refunding any surplus credit from these fundraisers. Any amount raised above your Organization Fee can be donated to another player or to the NPYHA general fund.

## Refunds

If a player makes a travel team accepts their position and then decides to leave NPYHA, their commitment fee and organizational fee WILL NOT BE refunded, except for the reasons listed below:

1. If you move from the Pittsburgh region prior to the start of the season, NPYHA will release you from our rosters and refund your commitment fee.
2. If you move after the start of the season, NPYHA will release you from our rosters and pro-rate your reimbursement based on your departure date.
3. Injury refund – no refund for the first month of injury, \$100 per month thereafter. Must have doctor's note.
