The Line-up:

Marty Paulsen-One of Wisconsin’s Coaching treasurers, Paulsen retired last season after serving 54 years as the Head Baseball Coach at Fond du Lac High School. Still a member of the State Coaches Executive Board, “Lou” is a member of several Coaches Hall of Fames including the prestigious ABCA Hall of Fame.

Darin Everson- Recently named as the Hitting Coach for the AA New York Mets Minor League Team, Darin has had an outstanding career in professional baseball including stints as hitting coordinator for the Colorado Rockies and as a scout in the Baltimore Orioles organization. Everson distinguished himself in two sports at Mayville State, earning many honors as a catcher on the baseball team and as the quarterback for football. In baseball he was an NAIA All-American catcher and led the 1993 MSU team to a runner-up finish in the national regional finals, while in football, he was the starting quarterback and earned honorable mention all-conference honors.

John Vodenlich- No stranger to Northern Wisconsin Coaches, Vodenlich is among the best college coaches in the country and his Warhawk teams have won National Championships in both 2005 and 2014. He is a two-time National Coach of the Year and a member of the WBCA Hall of Fame. As a player, he was an ABCA All-American in

both 1991 and 1992, the first two-time All-American at UW-Whitewater. His career record with the Warhawks is an outstanding 682-244 and he also serves as the National Coach for the country of Serbia.

Nick Winecke-The Head Baseball Coach at Saint Mary's University of Minnesota, Coach Winecke also serves as an Associate Athletic Director at the University. His 2021 squad set a single-season program record with 30 wins, won their first-ever MIAC Playoff title, and made its first NCAA Regional appearance since 1993. He was a four-year letter winner as a player at the University, serving as a Team Captain and earning All-MIAC First Team Honors.

Host Mark Fuller- During 34-years as the Head Coach of the Beavers, his teams compiled a record of 482-243. This will be his tenth year as an Assistant at UW-Whitewater, where has been fortunate to have been part of eight WIAC Conference Championships, two College World Series appearances, and one National Championship as a member of Coach John Vodenlich's staff.
