

2026 TBall Rules



3 innings or 1.5 hours

All balls are to be hit from the tee until May 1st. Beginning that day teams have the option for coach pitch for the first two strikes, after which the ball will be placed on the tee.

Batters have four attempts to hit the ball fair and past the arc. If the batter fails to do so then they will be called out.

Hit ball must pass the 15-foot arc to be a fair ball.

Batters will receive one warning for a thrown bat and will be called out for a second offense.

Play is marked dead when ball reaches pitchers circle.

All players play. You will run a regular infield and all other players will be in the outfield.

No more than 4 infielders at any one time (Excluding pitcher and catcher)

Outfielders must start in the grass.

All players bat when team is at bat.

No outs (unless coaches agree before game; however, outs do not count to change of innings)

Bat Rule: Must have a USA Baseball T-Ball Stamp

*All Divisions: Runner at home plate or base intentionally and maliciously runs into defensive player in the area will be called out and ejected from the game; umpire discretion

*All Divisions: If any bat cannot be clearly identified for its make and model to determine the barrel composition, then the bat should be removed from the game.

Coach/Player/Fan that is ejected from the game must leave the park immediately. If the individual that is ejected refuses to leave the park, their team forfeits the game. The coach or player that was ejected will be suspended for their next game. Ejection is at the discretion of the umpire. The manager of the team has 24hrs to appeal an ejection to the league representative and rules committee.
