## **Age Groups**

Distance will be adjusted for each age group.

Rookie / Single A / 6U (6 and under)

AA / 8U (7 / 8)

AAA / 10U (9 / 10)

Majors / 12U (11 / 12)

Adult 13+

## **Schedule**

Please [sign up for your time slot](#) by **noon on Friday 9/25**, and note the player's name and age / division last played.

Each player gets two minutes to hit all the home runs they can. The five-minute time slot breaks down as follows:

1 minute set-up / warm-up

2 minutes to hit all the home runs you can. Final "Drake Ball" = counts as two home runs

2 minutes transition / sanitizing

## **Positions on Field**

1. Hitter (Player)

2. Shagger (Supplied by player)

3. Pitcher (Supplied by player)

4. Timer (Supplied by league)

5. Counter (Supplied by league)

## **Championship Round – Saturday, September 26 – 4:30-6pm**

The top three home run hitters by age group will each get two minutes to hit all the home runs they can. The player in each age group with the most home runs wins!

## **Other Requirements**

1. Every person in attendance (volunteers and teams) is required to complete and sign the City's waiver. Please email to [esllboardpres@gmail.com](mailto:esllboardpres@gmail.com) no later than noon on Thurs 9/24.
2. Each team (hitter, shagger, pitcher) must be composed of people living in the same household.
3. At least six (6) feet distance between people of different households / teams and eight (8) feet distance during times of heavy physical exertion are required.
4. Spectators and fans are not allowed. Derby will be live-streamed so fans can watch from home and not onsite.
5. Only one team will be allowed in the hockey rink at one time. All participants will be asked to show up at their designated time slot only, and will be required to leave as soon as their turn is complete.
6. In-person, on-site screening (check-in concerning fever, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing and fever or chills, and whether the person has had contact with a person known or suspected to be infected with COVID-19 within the last 14 days) will be required.
7. We encourage each team to bring their own official Wiffle balls and bat to limit any sharing of equipment. We will have Wiffle balls and bats on-hand for those who need them, and will sanitize everything between teams.
8. Masks and gloves/batting gloves will be worn at all times. Disposable gloves, masks and hand sanitizer will be made available for anyone in need.
9. No shared water or food allowed.
