

## What to Expect Next: Thank you for registering to play for Chesapeake Little League!

You will receive communication from the League as we get closer to the opening of the Spring Season. If you have any questions, you can visit our [WEBSITE](#) for more information. You can also access contact information for the Vice President of your Division, Player Agent, Information Officer or any other League Officials that may assist you.

### **When will I know what team my player is on?**

All players will be placed on teams the second week of March. Managers will receive their rosters via email no later than March 12<sup>th</sup>. Players will then be contacted by their coach via phone call, text, or email. Practices are scheduled to begin March 16<sup>th</sup>

### **What if I don't receive a phone call from my coach by Friday March 13<sup>th</sup>?**

In the rare occasion this happens, please feel free to contact the Vice President of your respective division. ### **Is the League holding evaluations?**

Yes, all Minor and Major aged baseball and softball players must attend the mandatory evaluation on Saturday March 7<sup>th</sup> at Dbat Batting Cages. More information will be sent out prior to March 1<sup>st</sup>.

If your baseball player is an 8 year old in the Farm division (with previous experience) and would like to try out for the Minor Division, you must attend the baseball evaluation. This is not a guarantee that your child will move divisions, but a chance for the coaches to assess their level of skill. Currently, Junior and Senior players do not have to attend an evaluation; however, if registration numbers require an evaluation, players will be notified accordingly.

All players in the Minor/Major divisions must go through an evaluation to be drafted.

### **When do games begin?**

Opening Day is expected for April 4<sup>th</sup> at 9 am at the Crestwood fields (date and time subject to change)

### **How often will my player practice?**

<u>Age Group</u>	<u>Preseason</u>	<u>In-Season</u>
T-ball	2 practices	1 practice, 1 game on Saturdays only
Farm	2 practices	1 practice, 1 or 2 games
Minors to Senior	3 practices	1 or 2 practices, 2 games

**Will there be umpires at the games?**

We are the only Little League in District 6 to use volunteer and paid umpires for our Minor, Major, Junior and Senior divisions. In the event a volunteer umpire is unavailable, the League will arrange for a paid umpire. Umpires who work at least 8 full games in a season are eligible for one child's registration to be refunded.

**When will my player receive their uniform?**

Uniforms should be distributed to each team by the beginning of April. Most team uniforms are ordered in standard sizes, and your size input thru registration helps us to ensure we have coverage. If a special need should arise, rest assured we have a fabulous uniform manager that will assist in meeting your needs. As a reminder, players will receive the following uniform items this season:

**Tball & Farm:** Hat and Shirt

**Minor/Major/Junior/Senior Baseball:** Hat, Shirt, Pants, and Belt

**Minor/Major/Senior Softball:** Visor, Shirt, and Belt

**When does the season end?**

The season will end June 13<sup>th</sup> for most of our League. Players 9 and above may try out for the All Star team in their age group.

**How will I know if games are cancelled?**

Rain delays and cancelations are posted on our Facebook page and put out through each individual team. Please find and like us on Facebook if you haven't already done so in order to receive the most up to date information.

**Are there separate rules for each division?**

Yes, each coach will have printed copies of the rules, per Little League International, Inter-League District 6 rules, and/or local rules.
