Hall of Fame Nomination Procedures

- 1) All nominations must be by completion of the official Nomination Form. Nominations must be received by December 15th of the year to be considered.
 - 2) One letter of support from people personally acquainted with the candidate's accomplishments must accompany the Nomination Form.
 - 3) Nomination for any individual is in one category only — Player, Builder, Coach, or Hockey Official
 - 4) “Supportive Information” on the Nomination Form must include information which would support the candidate in the category for which he/she is nominated, and may include information from the opposite category. This section should also include information about civic, social and community activities which would lend to the candidate's selection for induction.
 - 5) To be eligible for nomination, a candidate must have been actively involved with South Dakota Amateur Hockey Association.
 - a. Player Category: A candidate for election as a Member in the player category shall be chosen on the basis of his or her playing ability, sportsmanship, character and contributions to his or her team or teams and to the game of hockey in general. A person is not eligible for election in the player category if he or she has played in a SDAHA sanctioned hockey game, USA Hockey sanctioned hockey game or a Collegiate Hockey during any of the three (3) playing seasons immediately prior to his or her election.
 - b. Builder Category: A candidate for election as a Member in the builder category shall be chosen on the basis of his or her managerial or executive ability (or ability in another significant off-ice role), sportsmanship, character and contributions to his or her organization or organizations and to the game of hockey in general. A candidate for election in the builder category may be either active or inactive at the time of his or her election.
 - c. Coaching Category: A candidate for election as a Member in the coaching category shall be chosen on the basis of his or her coaching or managerial ability, sportsmanship, character and contributions to his or her team or teams and to the game of hockey in general. A candidate for election in the coaching category may be either active or inactive at the time of his or her election.
 - d. Hockey Officials Category: A candidate for election as a Member in the Hockey Officials category shall be chosen on the basis of his or her officiating ability, sportsmanship, character and contributions to his or her organization or organizations and to the game of hockey in general. A candidate for election in the Hockey Officials category may be either active or inactive at the time of his or her election.
 - 6) A candidate may only be nominated in one category per year and Candidates for Membership may be living or deceased.
