

DASC SCRIP PROGRAM

A Basic "First Look" Outline

Descriptions and Links

Scrip is a term that means "substitute money". DASC is utilizing a scrip program through RaiseRight fundraising. 75% of the fundraising dollars earned will go back to your player's team account. The remaining 25% will be split as a donation to the DASC Scholarship Program (20%) and to Admin costs (5%).

When: July 8, 2025, members can get the app, register for the Scrip program, and start purchasing/earning.

Why: To supplement your players' Team Account and/or raise funds for the DASC Scholarship Program.

How: Go to the DASC Website: www.dakotaalliancesoccer.com/scrip

Look for the Invitation to Participate Letter, the DASC FAQ's, and the RaiseRight FAQ's

What (will I earn): 75% of what you earn will go to your player's team account with the remaining portion split as a donation to the DASC Scholarship Program (20%) and to defer the program admin costs (5%).

Basic Info:

- Members set up accounts using an app & an enrollment code specific to DASC.
- You "earn" a percentage, set by the retailers, for each card purchased.
- Members can invite others to join under a players account. Admin would need to know what player they are signing up under. See the Invite to Participate or the DASC FAQs for details.
- Members can use the app to view their account to keep track of purchases.

Physical Card vs eGift Card Options:

-eGift Cards: available immediately on the app or printed out and presented at the stores.

-Physical Cards: people can order these and have them shipped to their home for a fee.

Payout Schedules will be as follows:

-Earnings from the 2 months prior to each payout will be sent to team accounts. Payouts will be sent to the team treasurers in September, November, January, March, May, & July each season. Anything earned in July and August would go toward the next season or as donations to the DASC Scholarship Program.
