- Sponsorship and Fundraising Updates (Angela, Eric, Josh & Meranda)
 - Cash Raffle - net profit \$15,485.50, slightly behind budget but above last year, \$500 per player (31), 2024 \$428 per player (36), 2023 \$259 per player (30).
 - Give packets next year at STP for returning players
 - Need to put directions w/ Venmo to make it easier for Grant
 - Maintain same budget for next year
 - HyVee Bagging - 1st raised \$1,639.22.
 - Chow Nights - \$1,807 raised thus far which is over double the budget of \$830, awaiting North 20 check and 11/24 Culvers Venmo totals.
 - Next year cut down the ones that don't make money and do more of the others including through the spring and summer

- Program Ads - Quickbooks (unaudited) - net profit \$8,823.50 slightly ahead of budget and over \$1,700 higher than last year. Total Ad Value including trade is \$2,300 higher.
 - Keep budget similar for next year
 - Chuck-A-Puck / Cookie Sales - #1 sold most puck, lost money on cookies; #2 donated to Sophie's Squad. Should instruct cash sales to be given to Grant/Josh at the end of the second period prior to the chucking of pucks
 - Coffee Sales - Thus far \$259 with little promotion, perhaps we can get the word out on social media, will get one check at the end of the season.
 - Put it on the website
 - Bingo Night - Jan 9th prep is in process.
 - Burger baskets meal deal
 - Pre-pay tickets to venmo - need "Bingo" in memo
 - \$25 per card or discount for multiples
 - Winners with ties will split the prize
 - Laminated Venmo card
 - Verify how much for cash payout and how many games being played
 - Cash raffle- how many times to do - 3??
 - Live auction for items/baskets:
 - Frost tickets
 - Wild item
 - A few baskets - 2-4 - UMD, wine;
 - Idea for online ability to bid on basket
 - Blankets - 527 sold, net profit \$8,959, sales of 600 equals net profit of \$10,200.
