TEAM COVID SAFETY COORDINATORS NEEDED!

As a condition of hosting league play for the Spring 2021 season, Southern Nevada Soccer Association was required to submit a Return-To-Play Safety Plan for approval by the Nevada Department of Business & Industry. The plan includes a requirement that All SNSA teams appoint a COVID Safety Coordinator (CSC) to work with coaches, players, parents, referees and league officials to ensure that all team members comply with health and safety guidelines. The following are the responsibilities of the CSC:

- Register with SNSA as COVID Safety Coordinator for the Spring 2021 season.
- Review local and national health guidelines in relation to COVID-19, as well as SNSA Return-to-Play Protocols and State of Nevada Directive 034 for Youth Sports.
- Remind all players, coaches and spectators to follow the guidelines – wearing masks (when not actively participating), social distancing, etc.
- Ensure that all players, coaches, managers and spectators have their temperature taken and fill out an at-home health assessment prior to traveling to practice and games.
- Take proper steps to alert SNSA if a team member tests positive, shows symptoms, or has been exposed to someone who tests positive for COVID-19.
- Communicate with the coach and referee at games to ensure protocols are being followed on the sidelines. Games will not commence until sidelines are in compliance.
- Ensure that shared equipment is properly and frequently sanitized.
- Report to SNSA if any player, spectator or attendee fails to comply with COVID safety protocols. If the same individual or group is asked to comply 3 times within the same game or has had a complaint notification to the CSC by 3 individuals, the CSC shall notify the SNSA field marshal to initiate disciplinary action.

We ask for one parent volunteer from each team to register with SNSA as their team's COVID Safety Coordinator; no experience or training is required! **Go to the SNSA website and click on the "TEAM COACH & STAFF REGISTRATION button to register.** NOTE: A team manager or assistant coach can also serve as the team's COVID Safety Coordinator. It is our preference that the head coach not also serve as CSC, as his or her focus should be on coaching the team.
