

Centennial Sports Arena Covid-19 Guidelines

Winter Season 2020-21

These guidelines have been established for the safety and well-being of the sports arena staff and our patrons. Our staff is small and we may not be able to enforce guidelines at all times due to the nature of ice arena operations. However, we are required to report any teams that are not compliant with these guidelines. **Repeat offenders may lose the privilege to skate at Centennial Sports Arena.** We need you to be a responsible patron and member of the hockey community and follow the guidelines closely. If everyone takes this policy seriously and follows it willingly, we can keep our doors open and continue to play and watch the sports we love.

1. **A mask is required at all times. Players and coaches are required to wear a mask in team rooms as well.** Masks are not required on the ice for players. **Coaches must wear masks at all times, including on the ice.**
2. Participants are not to enter the building until 15 minutes before scheduled ice time. Goalies may enter 20 minutes prior. Please arrive dressed in 1/2 gear. Exceptions will be made for goaltenders to put on extra gear in the team room.
3. Participants must exit the building no later than 10 minutes past the end of designated ice time. **Coaches must enforce this guideline.**
4. No team meetings, chalk talks, or dryland activities are allowed except in the 15 minutes prior to ice time.
5. No more than two coaches allowed on the bench for games and scrimmages.
6. Bring your own water. Do not share water bottles. **All water fountains will be unavailable.**
7. Spectators are not allowed in the building for practices except for players who require assistance or are under the age of 11. These participants may have one adult present to help them.
8. There may be circumstances in which a parent or guardian may have to bring with a young sibling into the arena. This will be allowed for **1 sibling only**, but should be limited as much as possible.
9. Only two spectators per player will be allowed during scrimmages or games. This includes High School games.
10. Centennial Sports Arena Guidelines will take precedence over any outside organization guidelines with the exception of the State of Minnesota or the CDC.
11. **Checks of guideline compliance will be done by ISD 12 staff regularly.**
