Who can attend Prom?

Prom is hosted for WHS 11th and 12th grade students and their 9th grade through Post-High School guests. Everyone must have a ticket.

Ticket Information:

- There are **NO In-Person tickets sales including at the prom venue**
- All tickets are \$30 + processing fee per person and must be purchased in advance of prom.
- Online tickets will be available Monday, March 16 - Friday, April 24, 2026 at 12 Noon.
- Only Junior and Senior WHS students will be allowed to purchase tickets online. All guests that do not attend Woodbury High School must have tickets purchased by the WHS student that is bringing them as a guest. A completed WHS dance guest form will be required on file in the Activities Office prior to purchasing tickets for non-sowashco district and post-high school guests.

Guest Information

- All guests must bring ID with them to be admitted into the prom Venue
- There is one guest per WHS student (only 2 tickets may be purchased per WHS student)
- Guests must arrive with and be accompanied by the designated WHS student throughout the evening of Prom.

What if my guest is from another school?

- Guests within South Washington County Schools (East Ridge, Park, Online, or Alternative) may attend prom as a guest of a WHS student; they must arrive with the host student and present their student ID at the entrance of prom. They do ***not*** need to complete the WHS dance guest form.
- Guests in grades 9-12 attending a school outside of South Washington County Schools must complete the WHS dance guest form.
 - **This form must be signed by an administrator from the guest's own high school.**
 - This form must be turned in by the WHS student to the Activities Office by Thursday, April, 23, 2026 at 3:15 PM prior to purchasing a ticket for the guest.

What if my guest has already graduated or is Post High School?

- Any guest that is of post high school age (age 19 and older) must first meet with a WHS Assistant Principal before Wednesday, April 22, 2026 at 3PM prior to purchasing a ticket. This meeting must be scheduled 2 days in advance of the meeting date. Contact the Assistant Principal assigned to your alphabet to set up the meeting. They must present their ID (i.e. Drivers License, State issued ID) at the entrance of prom. A WHS dance guest form must be filled out and signed by the WHS administrator and turned into the activity office by Thursday, April, 23, 2026 at 3:15 PM prior to purchasing a ticket for the guest.
