- K.Urankar motion to approve last month's meeting minutes / Unanimous approval
- M. Adamek – possible tournament invite to U6/U8
 - Tourney in PC over Christmas break
 - Not run by PCIM – good opportunity for younger players 1st tourney
 - Additional cost
 - 8U/6U going to Jackson in March
 - 14U AA coaching change
 - Head coach & Asst Coach switching roles (AJ & Ray)
 - 6U/8U
 - 2-3 per month cross ice games
 - #s – 17 6Us
 - 49 8Us
 - A few with experience but also some very new hockey payers
 - 10U/12U house
 - 10u- 10 registered players
 - 12u – 13
 - Cal Lloyd held a Zoom get together
 - 12U/10U teams appear good to go
 - No goalies but that is not unusual for D2
- D2 doesn't need full ice on their own for each team
- 8U/6U
 - Cross ice for upper squad of 10-15 kids
 - Will grow from playing against each other vs newer players
 - Open ice – consider giving to 8U
- D2 still registered as House for now
 - Travel B gives house more chances to play
 - Goal is to match up teams regardless of how they're rostered
 - We can only play Lightning Fridays & Sundays
 - Davis County – Fridays sometimes
 - WE can still call them House/D2 – nothing changes about our Charter or how we refer to them / how the team commitment is presented to players/families
 - This would only be for rostering them with UAHA
 - The only downside is roster locks Dec 15
 - Resolved – Ashlei to roster them as Travel B
- Jans Winter Welcome volunteer sign up
 - More volunteer response than we normally get
 - 82 opportunity drawing tickets sold
 - Should be uptick as we get closer

- o What do we get from YSA?
 - Some proceeds from auction items
 - 100% of opp drawing ticket sales
 - Helps us pay overhead costs
 - So each team can be self sufficient (in player fees vs. team cost)
