Hundreds of community members take advantage of the Ski/Snowboard Swap to trade up or clean out equipment they no longer use. Local ski shops also bring in great deals for the SWAP. Professional ski/snowboard shop staff and experienced skiers/boarders are on hand to help you. The Ski & Snowboard SWAP is run by volunteers as a fundraiser for Team Duluth Ski and Snowboard Club 501.3.C, with all proceeds used to make our programs more affordable to area youth. Please note: Nordic (Cross Country) skis are not handled by the SWAP – Alpine/Snowboard Equipment only.

### SELLING PROCEDURE

Bring in your equipment in during Drop Off times listed above.

All items should be clean/washed and less than 5 years old.

There is a \$2 fee per item that you wish to sell.

Sales status can be **checked online** during the sale to see if your item has sold. If it has, you will receive a check in about a month for the sale price less a 20% Team Duluth commission.

Equipment that hasn't sold must be picked up before 1 pm Sunday afternoon, or we will donate or recycle it.

There is a 3% fee on all credit card transactions and NO SALES TAX
