- The Steel set a franchise record by winning their 11th straight game, a 4-3 victory against the Dubuque Fighting Saints at Mystique Community Ice Center on Saturday night ... Chicago has won 18 of their last 19 games, dating back to Nov. 2 ... With the victory, the Steel are the first team in the USHL to reach the 50-point plateau this season...Chicago killed off 2-of-3 (66.6%) penalties taken in the win and tallied a shorthanded goal...
- Chicago scored two goals in the final minute of play to overcome a 3-2 deficit.
- **Erik Middendorf** tallied the game-winning goal for the second consecutive night. The forward has totaled 14 points (7G, 7A) in 16 games this season.
- **Sean Farrell** notched a multi-point game with a marker and a helper. Farrell paces all USHL skaters with 39 points (11G, 28A).
- **Matty De St. Phalle** registered a goal and an assist in the win. He now has 37 points (17G, 20A) this year.
- **Mackie Samoskevich** registered his seventh marker of the season and picked up his 12th helper of the year.
- **Sam Colangelo** recorded a two-assist night while **Gunnarwolfe Fontaine** picked up a helper in the win.
- **Ian Shane** made 27 saves in the win, pushing his record to 9-1-1-0 this year.
