 - a. Volunteer Agreement with \$350 deposit check for City League only families / Travel Family is \$700 – **one per family**
 - b. Substance Policy/USA Hockey Code of Conduct for **ICL & ACL Only**
 - c. IcePlex Waiver – Form was available during registration to complete & upload
 - d. **Forms & check can be placed in the red box located on the floor near the concession door at the rink**
 - e. Age Definitions – League determined by birth year **Leagues are Atoms, Mites, ICL & ACL**
