Shrine Game nominations are down and the number of kids who have declined to play is way up. Doug Winkowitsch suggested to Jerry Hoffman to have coaches nominate players on-line in 2019. Jay Rozeboom from West Lyon and Butch Pedersen from West Branch will be the Head Coaches for the 2019 Shrine All-Star Football Game.

Distinguished Service: Ok. The Distinguished Service Award Nomination Form will be emailed out to all Head Football Coaches at the end of the football season or near the end of the football season.

Membership: We are currently at 64%. 212 out of 331 High Schools, 16 Iowa Colleges, 4 Out-Of-State Colleges, 1 Youth Program (Emmetsburg), and 15 Individuals. Membership email reminders will continue to be sent periodically to remind coaches to get their 2018 Iowa Football Coaches' Association Membership Dues paid. One suggestion/idea that was brought up was a one time membership fee for retired coaches. Iowa Football Coaches' Association Board Of Directors were instructed to give this suggestion/idea some thought and a decision will be made at the Fall Board Of Directors' Meeting in regards to a one time membership fee for retired Football Coaches.

Playoff Advisory: Everyone appears to be let's just "wait and see" in regards to the RPI and the Playoffs as "it is what it is" right now.

IFCA Clinic: IFCA Executive Secretary Ken Winkler plans to meet with IFCA Clinic Director Jason Buske in the near future about some possible IFCA Clinic changes. These changes include the Iowa Football Coaches' Association taking over the IFCA Clinic Registrations, taking over the Hall Of Fame Banquet Reservations to make sure we get all of our Hall Of Fame members recognized at the Hall Of Fame Banquet, and a Fellowship Of Christian Athletes Breakfast on Saturday morning of the IFCA Clinic.

Playoff Hospitality: IFCA Playoff Hospitality Committee Chairman Aundra Meeks recommends to stay with what has been done in the past in regards to the IFCA Hospitality Area at the UNI-Dome during the State Championship Games one more year. Possibly reduce the quantity that we are ordering for the two days by a little bit and see if we can promote it more by encouraging coaches to join us. One idea Coach Meeks had was to ask Adrenaline if they would sponsor pizza for the coaches. Coach Meeks believes this would definitely bring more coaches to our Hospitality Room/Area. Discussion followed, but no action was taken at this time.

Yearbook: We will have a IFCA Yearbook this year as long as we have the funding. The big question in regards to our funding that remains is whether or not we are going to be able to keep Adrenaline as a IFCA Yearbook Sponsor. This will be Coach Winkler's last year as IFCA Yearbook Committee Chairman. The Iowa Football Coaches' Association Board Of Directors' will need to make a decision in regards to the future of the IFCA Yearbook at the Fall Meeting.
