We feel that KY judges should judge our KY state meet, and we need an updated judges list of whom is available and what KY judges have been judging KY meets during the season.

It is mirroring some of the regional qualifying scores, and we like the higher mobilizing score to help promote better gymnastics in the state of KY.

Small and Large Team at KY State Meet

Clarification on what is in our R and P:

Team Size definition:

Levels 2, 3 and Xcel Bronze, Silver and Gold will be divided into two team divisions, Small and Large to be split down the middle.

*For Level 2 and 3, after all entries are in, the meet director will split team exactly down the middle to determine Large and Small team awards. If the split is uneven they will use alphabetical order and that team will move down to small team. It was brought to our attention that the Level 2-3 Bronze and Silver state meet had an uneven split and the meet director needed clarification on how to split the team. We will revise the wording at our summer meeting for the next R and P to make sure there is no question on how to split the teams at our KY state meets. There is a team of 17 level 2's that were in question. Level 2 and 3 are uneven with 5 teams. Bronze, Silver and Gold have enough teams that the split should be even.

Debbie Klotz made a motion to move the group of 17 up to Large Team at the Level 2-3, Bronze and Silver 2022 KY State Meet. Same applies for Level 3; there will be three large teams and two small teams.
