Scholarship Application Guidelines

Purpose - To ease the financial burdens associated with membership at an elite training facility such as Summit Wrestling Academy. Summit prioritizes the membership and participation of athletes who are motivated and goal-oriented. As such, Summit will be awarding scholarships to deserving applicants who have demonstrated a strong desire to train hard and dedicate themselves to success in the sport of wrestling.

Who Qualifies? - Any youth, age 18 and under, who desires to train at Summit. Scholarships are *limited*; please note that some financial information may be requested.

Scholarship Requirements

Individuals who are awarded scholarships are required to attend a minimum of 80% of scheduled practices, lessons or Summit special events. Scholarship recipients are still required to pay their adjusted membership balance in a timely manner. Failure to meet attendance requirements, and/or overdue payments may result in the loss of scholarship for your household.

Application Process

1. Complete the Scholarship Application Form, which must be signed by a parent/guardian.
2. Email to summitwrestlingacademy@gmail.com by **Monday, October 14, 11:59 PM**
3. An employee from Summit will confirm via email that we received your application.
4. Scholarship application approval will be based on availability of scholarship funds, and selected applicants will be informed via email or phone call and presented via social media (Facebook) on **October 21, 2019**.

Other Important Information

- Scholarship amounts are based on total family size and total family income. Families are defined as parent(s)/guardian(s) and dependents all living at the same address.
- Scholarships will be granted for use at Summit only.
- Completing a Scholarship Application **DOES NOT** register a child for a training program. Please complete the online registration at www.summitwrestling.org
- Scholarships will be provided.

Confidentiality – *Summit Wrestling Academy will not release information pertaining to financial situations. We will request to share via social media the recipients of available scholarships with the approval of parents/guardians. This is to demonstrate the validity of the scholarship and its process.*
