### NEW BUSINESS/Discussion/Voting Items

- 2021 League registration
  - 2021 Registration fees
    - \$25 Pee Wee \$50 for Tee Ball and \$75 for all other leagues.
    - Greg Reimann motioned to keep 2021 registration fees at the same level as 2020.
      - Mark Lund seconded motion. **Motion approved.**
  - Timeline
    - Open league registration Jan.1
    - Close league registration Feb. 28
    - Close Tee Ball registration April 30
- Discussed giving consideration to separating TeeBall out into 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year. 2<sup>nd</sup> year would maybe start out as TeeBall and advance through the season to coach pitch. Agreed that this is a good idea to investigate further but this would not be a good year to try to implement coming off of a season off due to COVID and this close to registration. Would like to see this idea investigated further and possibly considered for 2022 implementation.
