# Week 8 of Play

## GAME SUMMARIES:

In a pitcher's duel with playoff's on the line a 0-0 score in the 5th added to the drama. But J.

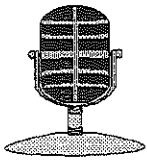

YMSL- What about you?

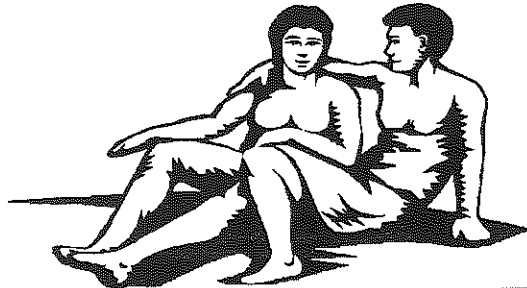
MS- I spend a lot less, and get a lot more, if you know what I mean.

YMSL- Why did you agree to this interview?

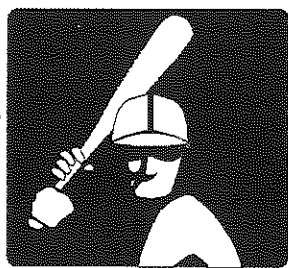
