 - Golf Tournament results
 - Raised over \$10,000
 - \$1,010 of this amount was raised at the cruise hole in one challenge courtesy of Gutierrez Travel, which will go to the high school team.

 - Raised over \$16,990. Plans are in the works for construction of the shooting zone and communication will go out once details are finalized.
