Baseball – hit-a-thon successful – using funds to renovate batting cages, and repurpose, upgrade facilities; this is included in our budget for next year. As for the season, we just came off a good win against MR, trying to win enough to make late push for District.

Tennis – Varsity District, freshman got 3rd place! Potentially sending one to regionals as an alternate. JV and Freshman District are tomorrow (4/4).

Swimming – ended a while ago but gave out awards and accolades, 6 All-State, 2 All-American, 4 Academic All-American, a former THS swimmer at UT right now won 200 butterfly (4th fastest ever) and was name SEC female athlete of the year.

Boys Soccer – finished 5th in district; all 4 from our district played to third round; hoping to build on that for next year.

Boys & Girls track – 2 weeks ago in Klein, boys broke 4x200 relay record (2006 - one of our coaches was member of that record). Girls and Boys relay teams went to Austin for Texas relays. Thanks to the Booster Club for covering hotel rooms. Girls broke 4x400 record (held since 2005). Sub varsity District meet starts tomorrow; varsity and freshman pushed to next week due to weather.

Volleyball – training for next year.

Football –start spring ball in two weeks; best off-season for athletes and coaches.
