Discussion(s):	<p>Kathleen mentioned that the comment within the previous minutes about “the better players we send, the more spots we get” is an urban legend and isn’t true. The number of spots available to Utah is based on the number of registered players. This was true 15+ years ago, but is no longer true. It is a % based formula for each birth year. She also mentioned that we are the only district that permits spot swapping, when there is a strong forward and a defensive slot is available, but the talent of Utah’s players is not a factor in the number of players invited to district camp.</p> <p>Robyn mentioned that previous registration numbers reported with PPR, although this will be reported without PPR going forward.</p> <p>Anna asked about the three programs that were given girls travel B, but the minutes also mentioned 4 travel B teams. This was clarified as Ogden, Oval</p>				



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	and Davis have girls travel B approval, along with ULG. No further changes were needed to the minutes for this.

Initial Discussion:	<p>As a reminder, with Courtney vacating the Girls VP position, there was no one to lead the charge on spending the UAHA money allocated to the event. Don volunteered to make this happen.</p> <p>The flyer was included in the agenda and was brought on the screen to show the events that were planned out. This included 4 skills sessions (Friday at the Oval with Yuri Ushakov, Saturday at KJs with Gabe Gauthier, Saturday at SDRC with JC93 and Saturday at SRDC with Mason Mannek. There was also a try hockey for free that was scheduled on Saturday morning at Steiner, with a request made for the various girls orgs to support. The desire was to have only girls on the ice, with a female coaching staff running the event. The girls orgs were asked to supply 2-3 responsible players to help push pucks and then a program rep there to answer questions as the girls came off the ice. At this</p>

Initial Discussion:	<p>5 candidates were named and offered 2 minutes some time ago after the board was presented with the bios:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jared Dain – Respectfully declined - Melissa Mossberg – very thrilled for nomination and looking forward to opportunity. Focus to bring strong voice to girls hockey and empower parents to with knowledge of how to support. Encourage girls and provide equal opportunity. Wants and supportive and unified hockey community for girls across the state. - Kristi Davis – Formerly with Ogden Girls and now the program coordinator. Wants to focus on breaking pyramid down and addressing the challenges at each range. For newer skaters / house – acquisition and connecting between LTP and a program. For travel B, the issue is perceived as retention. She left the state to play and wants to build a program so her girls don't need to do that to play competitive hockey. - Kristi – Mental performance coach used in Ogden. 2 ogden girls made the 16U lady grizz and 2 made it to state camp . New OJM coaches played lady grizz. Initial Discussion:	<p>Proposed from the Tier committee, to minimize the parents and players for competing for time between the various teams and tryouts.</p> <p>April 6 is last date of national tourney. 10 April is earliest for the tier 1 dates. This will be 2 weeks. ULG Tier 1, Tier 2 and travel tryouts over the subsequent 2 weeks. 10U/12U tryouts moved up to 26-27 April to prevent competition with other sports and spring tournaments. May 6-7 for tier 2, as blackout dates. The summary of all dates, as submitted by the tier committee:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">The following dates are requested to be reserved for Tryouts:</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">April 10th – April 13th, 2025 – Tier I Tryouts April 17th – April 20th, 2025 – Tier I Tryouts April 17th – April 20th, 2025 – Utah Lady Grizzlies Tier I / Tier II/ Travel Tryouts April 24th – April 27th, 2025 – Utah Lady Grizzlies Tier I / Tier II / Travel Tryouts April 22nd – April 27th, 2025 – 10U/12U Travel Tryouts May 6th – May 11th, 2025 – Tier II Tryouts May 13th – May 18th, 2025 – Girls Travel B Tryouts May 28th – June 1, 2025 – 14U-18U Travel Tryouts</p>					



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	<p>This was approved during the last tier committee. Rocky Mountain District camp for girls is in May. The tier II dates cannot be extended by more than a couple of days without competing.</p> <p>Anna asked about the dates, if they were protected or if those are the only dates available. The dates are confirmed to be blackouts dates, where nothing else can be one on those weekends.</p> <p>For girls, why is the set-up for tier I not aligned with other tier I dates. It was confirmed that this was done to align with the previous year's events.</p> <p>It was also asked why the girls travel B is not aligned with the other travel B dates and it was decided that this was best, to enable girls to tryout for a coed team and girls' team, without competing schedules.</p> <p>A call for nomination was made, with Steve making the motion to approve the dates, as submitted. Presented By:	Frank Monestere (ULG)					
Initial Discussion:	<p>Frank indicated that a 15 year old player reached out because she was without a hockey team. She is from Reno and there is no girls or coed team. Northern California and Vegas teams she tried out did not work out.</p> <p>Brooke Morely, the team manager for the ULG 19U Team, indicated that she played 16U coed in Reno and that team disbanded last year. She really wants to play.</p> <p>ULG 19U Travel coach (Adica) indicated that she has seen video and believes that she can keep up. They are desperate for players, given the team only has 7 skaters and a goalie. They indicated that the family is planning to attend practice 1x a month.</p> <p>There was discussion on the release from Nevada and it was confirmed that we have both a program release and a release from Nevada's USAH affiliate. Geoff wondered if our rules permit this. Angela mentioned there is a stipulation in the P and P that permits the board to entertain requests for this, when there are certain factors. It was confirmed that this condition was met and that based on a roster size of 8, there are no Utah girls being displaced. Frank mentioned that the team is borderline viable and they are looking to</p>					



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	<p>complete the roster and compete with these girls. Kathleen confirmed that she is supposed to go to the closest rink, although Elko does not have a program. Geoff read a section of the P and P that stipulates no billeted players and it was confirmed that she would not be...she would travel for practice on occasion and for games.</p> <p>Chuck mentioned that this approval affords 8 Utah girls a better chance of playing travel level hockey in the year. Geoff reiterated that this is a special circumstance and does not open the flood gate for out of state players to infiltrate Utah.</p> <p>Robyn mentioned that our policy requires a travel team to have a roster of 13 and 1, but does not stipulate when this size needs to be met.</p> <p>Don made a motion to abandon the roster size requirement for travel girls and allow this girl to play for this season.</p> <p>There was contention on the term abandon and the motion was amended to stay “set aside” in lieu of abandon.</p>

Discussion(s):	<p>Geoff reiterated that this team is fragile. ULG is striving to get to a roster size of 10 and 1. These girls are higher level and don’t belong on travel teams. 13 and 1 provides a better chance for a viable team. Kristi T mentioned that it was common to see girls playing with a short roster.</p> <p>The board was very complimentary to the family for committing to driving this far, for the purpose of helping their daughter find a place to play.</p>

Agenda Item:	7	Topic:	Project Discussion Points / “Compass” for P & and P cleanup			
Presented By:	Don					
Initial Discussion:	<p>The discussion started around travel A vs travel B and house. It was confirmed that these discussions were to clarify the P and Ps for the future and not to complicate or change the direction we are headed for this season.</p> <p>Chuck mentioned that for the purpose of conversation, “Travel” should be replaced with “travel A”, D1 should be replaced with Travel B and D2 should be replaced with House / Rec.</p> <p>There was discussion about the model that DCYHA is using, with house teams playing within their rink week-to-week, and all skaters on a single flex roster. Additionally, there is a select group that has been identified to play on a “travel B” team, with the intent of playing in tournaments (in and out of state). The nuance that was concerning with this approach was that the players could</p>					



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	<p>not be dual rostered unless the “B” team was a tournament roster, which is a very episodic approval (e.g., approved for 1 tournament). The DC approach was to pull these same kids in for the entire season.</p> <p>There was a question that came up about a league program for the year, given that it is being stood up in Oct. This was tabled for now.</p> <p>Kathleen confirmed that this was done years ago because the travel players were coming to a single house team when the travel team was knocked out.</p> <p>Geoff mentioned that we need the Youth VP to be present for this meeting to decide further, although this discussion is more for the alignment of the P and P and not the set-up of the league.</p> <p>After discussion, it was confirmed that house teams are permitted to play in tournaments within Utah, using their flex roster. There is no limitation on the number of tournaments they play in within Utah. The options for house teams to combine and travel out of state are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Travel B tournament team (3 per age division / org) – rosters are valid for a single tournament - House Tournament Team (set roster from house flex roster- can be on this team and their house team) – valid for 3 tournaments out of state. May be used for in state, although not needed since the flex roster is also an option for the in-state tournaments. <p>All teams are still required to submit a travel permit when leaving the state.</p> <p>Discussed removing the youth league info from the P & P document, with the right refused to review annually. League rules are to be reviewed annually, during the June / annual meeting, so we approve the league structure and subsidies.</p> <p>In the interest of time, this is where the discussion stopped and no further actions were taken, but the direction was taken for the P&P sub-team to move forward with revision.</p>

The new divisions are 1A, 2A, and 3A, with 1-2 teams per affiliate eligible to submit. - The state is set for pure and combined, but they are looking at 1A, 2A and not nationally bound. - There was discussion on not participating in national and Kathleen mentioned we would not be eligible for 5 more years after. - Dealing with some discipline issues. - Girls teams are not nationally bound for the 2024 – 2025 season. - Practice players – are they allowed to participate in high school. It was confirmed that they would be rostered, since there is space. - Are out of state games permitted for HS teams? No policies that permit or prohibit them from going out of state, so long as a travel permit is submitted.

Steve was going to check with Madison and Bruder to see what was possible and report back. - It was asked if there were discount tickets available and the answer was no, since they are already fairly cheap and costs need to be covered.
