

# Big Sky Ski Trip

## January 26-30, 2022

This **BBSC** Sponsored trip to ski at **Big Sky Resort** and **Bridger Bowl** with lodging at **C'mon Inn**, off of I-90 in north Bozeman, MT with amenities that include a full buffet breakfast each day, five hot tubs, pool, exercise room, large comfortable gathering room for our wine and cheese party, and free WiFi Internet.

*We request all participants to be fully vaccinated prior to departure on January 26 or bring proof of a negative COVID test obtained within 48 hours prior to departure.*

**Wed, Jan 26** - Depart early morning from Boise on a luxury 56\* passenger touring coach with a brief stop in Idaho Falls for lunch (self pay). Beer, wine, beverages and snacks provided on the bus. Arrive at C'mon Inn early evening for a **BBSC** sponsored wine and cheese party. Dinner (self pay) at one of several nearby restaurants.

**Thur, Jan 27** - Depart hotel via bus for all day skiing at Big Sky Resort. Regarded as one of the premier ski mountains in the USA with exciting terrain for all levels of skiers, Big Sky participates in the IKON ski pass. Mountain Host tours will be arranged for those interested. Return to the hotel at 4 PM. Bus ride to downtown Bozeman (leaving hotel at 6 PM and returning 8-9 PM) with dinner on your own.

**Fri, Jan 28** - Depart hotel via bus for all day skiing at Bridger Bowl, a local mountain similar to Bogus Basin or Brundage and always a crowd favorite with fun terrain. Upon request Mountain Host tours may be available. Return to the hotel at 4 PM, and dinner on your own in downtown Bozeman bus leaving hotel at 6 PM and returning 8-9 PM.

**Sat, Jan 29** - Depart hotel via bus for all day skiing at Big Sky, returning at 4 PM. Dinner on your own.

**Sun, Jan 30** - Depart hotel early morning to return to Boise with a brief stop for lunch in Idaho Falls (self pay). Beer, wine, beverages and snacks provided on the bus. Arrive in Boise early evening.

The **Trip costs** include bus travel, tip for the driver, snacks and beverages on the bus, hotel room, full daily buffet breakfast (based on a minimum of 30 people participating, 37 already registered):

**\$485.00 per person (double occupancy)**

**\$743.00 per person (single occupancy)**

**BBSC** has secured **DISCOUNTED** Big Sky/Bridger Bowl lift tickets!

Both resorts will provide us with specific instructions on how to purchase their respective **discounted BBSC** lift tickets by November 15th. ***Please wait until you receive these instructions by separate email from the trip coordinator before you attempt to purchase.***

### **Bridger Bowl Lift Tickets:**

1 each RFID card*	\$ 5.00 (everybody must purchase card, including 80+ year old)
1 each 80 year or older lift ticket	\$ 0.00
1 each 70-80 year old lift ticket	\$ 39.00 (Normally \$54.00 at the window)
1 each regular Adult ticket	\$ 58.00 (Normally \$84.00 at the window)

### Big Sky Lift Tickets:

1 each RFID card*	\$ 5.00 (everybody but Ikon Pass holders must purchase card)
1 each 70+ year old lift ticket	\$119.00 (\$151 advance online, more at window day of purchase)
1 each regular Adult ticket	\$129.00 (\$189 advance online, \$220.00 at the window day of)

### Big Sky Tram prices:

Individual one day price	\$ 80.00 each day (option can be added the day of if you decide to purchase)
3 day advance purchase	\$150.00 (A better deal but use it or lose it)
5 day advance purchase	\$225.00

*\*RFID card does not expire, can be saved and reused/refilled every season*

Trip goers will be receiving a separate email providing instructions and the unique **Bogus Basin Ski Club** “link” and our **promo code** to use when buying lift tickets after November 15, 2021. For questions or assistance please contact Doug at 208-867-1286.

**Online registration for this BBSC trip** must be completed by December 26, 2021, with full amount due upon registration. You will have the option to pay online via credit card (~3% service charge) or off-line via personal check (see online registration for details). This trip is capped at **45** participants\*.

**Cancellation:** Charges for cancellation based on the date that your **written notice** of cancellation is received by **Doug Baker**, the **BBSC** leader for this trip are outlined below.

Please make your own arrangements to purchase trip insurance for this event if desired.

**50% refund** with written notice received by **November 26, 2021**

**25% refund** with written notice received by **December 26, 2021**

**No refunds after December 26, 2021**

**\*COVID-19 Safety Precautions:** Because of the ongoing COVID situation and the long rides in the confined space of a bus, we require that **all** participants on this trip be fully COVID vaccinated prior to our departure on January 26, 2022. If you have not yet received your COVID vaccinations, there is sufficient time to complete them prior to our departure. If you have already been vaccinated, we encourage you to obtain your COVID booster vaccination, which is available for most individuals six months after their initial vaccination. If you are not vaccinated prior to our departure, the only alternative is to provide a negative COVID test obtained no more than 48 hours prior to departure on January 26.
