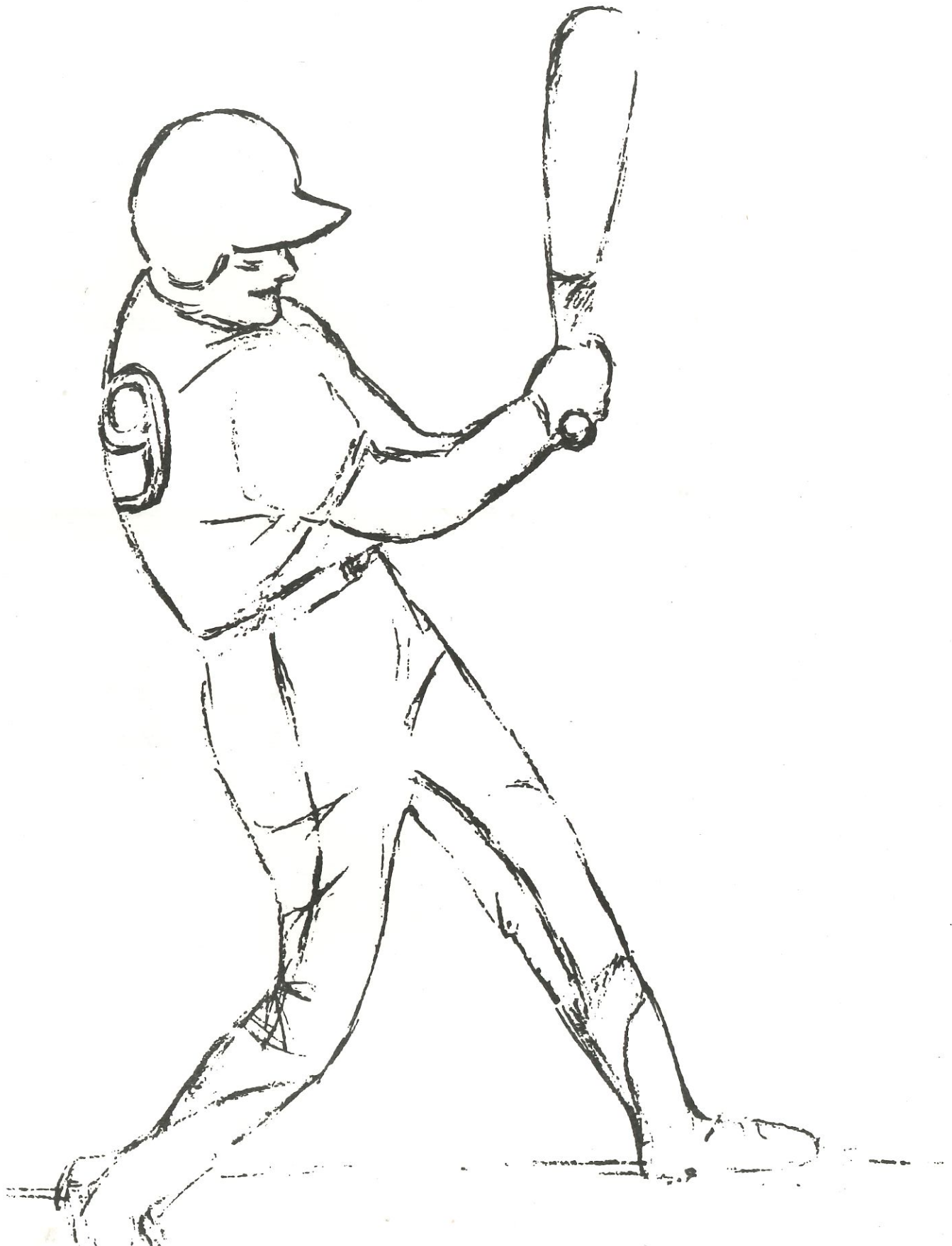

BIG TIME SWEEPS HEAT 12-9 AND 12-7.

BIG TIME CAME INTO THE GAME WITH A 1-3 RECORD NEEDING AT LEAST 1 WIN AGAINST REDS LEFT HANDED FASTBALL. CHARLIE'S BOY'S LEAD BY ZACK MISHANS 3 HOME RUN DAY (ONE A RUTHIAN BLAST TO DEAD CENTER) SWEEP A GOOD HEAT TEAM. BOTH GAMES WERE CLOSE BUT SAKA'S TRADEMARK IS WINNING THE CLOSE ONES AND THEY DID IT TWICE TODAY. ESPECIALLY IN THE SECOND GAME. AFTER JACKIE HADDAD'S 2 RUN HOME RUN GAVE HEAT A 7-2 LEAD, BIG TIME ROARED BACK. A VICTOR AZRAK HOME RUN AND CLUTCH HITS BY CHARLIE, MISHAN AND FALLAS TIED THE SCORE 7-7. THAT SET THE STAGE FOR JACK MISHAN TO BLAST ONE OVER JACKIE HADDAD'S HEAD TO SEAL THE VICTORY 8-7. I THINK LAST TIME RED LOST A DOUBLE HEADER IT WAS WHEN YOURS TRULY BEAT HIM TWICE IN TWICE IN 1980. MISSRY BELTED A HOME RUN INTO THE TEETH OF A STRONG WIND. GRAND SLAM RALLIED TO MAKE IT 7-5 AND THEN HARRY CATTON, AFTER HITTING A CLUTCH TRIPLE, MADE A BASE RUNNING BLUNDER AND WAS OUT AT THE PLATE. IT'S EITHER BAD BASE RUNNING OR BAD COACHING. IN ANY CASE GRAND SLAM LOOKS MUCH BETTER THAN THEIR RECORD AND NEEDS ONLY ONE DOUBLEHEADER WIN TO MOVE BACK INTO THE HUNT.

HAT TRICKS SHORTSTOP ZILBERMAN LOOKS AS GOOD AS VICTOR AND THAT'S SAYING ALOT. VICTORS ONE OF OUR FAVORITES. HAT TRICK DESERVES CREDIT FOR COMING BACK IN SECOND GAME AGAINST A GOOD PITCHER. INCIDENTLY MISSRY, BRAHA AND HADDAD ARE AS DANGEROUS AS ANY 3 HITTERS IN THE LEAGUE.

PALS AND PEACH'S SPLIT

PICCIOTO GETS SLAMMED 15-4 IN THE 1ST BUT BOUNCES BACK IN THE 2ND TO WIN 17-8. ALLIE MARSHALL AND MEYER ASSOULIN 2 OF THE NEW YOUNG WAVE OF THE PALS SLAM HOMERUNS TO LEAD THE PALS IN THE 1ST GAME. IN THE 2ND GAME ALAN ANTAR (4 FOR 6) AND A HOMERUN ALONG WITH DOUGLAS GOLDENBERG LEAD THE WAY FOR PEACH'S "N" CREAM. PALS NOW JUMP INTO SECOND PLACE WITH A 4-2 RECORD AND FACE THE LEAGUE LEADERS NEXT WEEK. IF THE PALS HAVE THEIR HITTING SHOES ON AND ZALTA IS SHARP THEY COULD HANDLE THE COCKY BEDROCKERS.

WERE GOING OUT ON A LIMB AND PREDICTING THE PALS TO SWEEP THE ROCKERS BEHIND ZALTA ON THE MOUND. PEACH'S WILL HAVE TO FACE THE RASCALS WITH ABIE BACK ON THE MOUND. THE RASCALS ARE DESPERATE AND CANNOT AFFORD MANY MORE LOSSES.

THE PALS SHOULD FARE BETTER BECAUSE THEY HAVE A LOT OF YOUNG GOOD PLAYERS. HEAT HAS JACKIE HADDAD AND RED NESSER WHO ALSO FARE BETTER AND ARE VERY DANGEROUS ON A CLEAR DAY WITH NO WIND. PICCIOTO AND IKEY FOR PEACH'S AND EDDIE MISHAN FOR BIG TIME WILL ALSO EXCEL WITH LESS WIND.

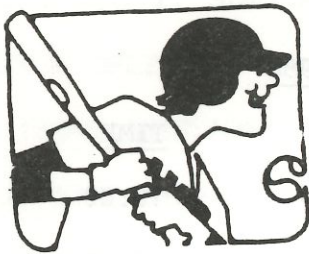
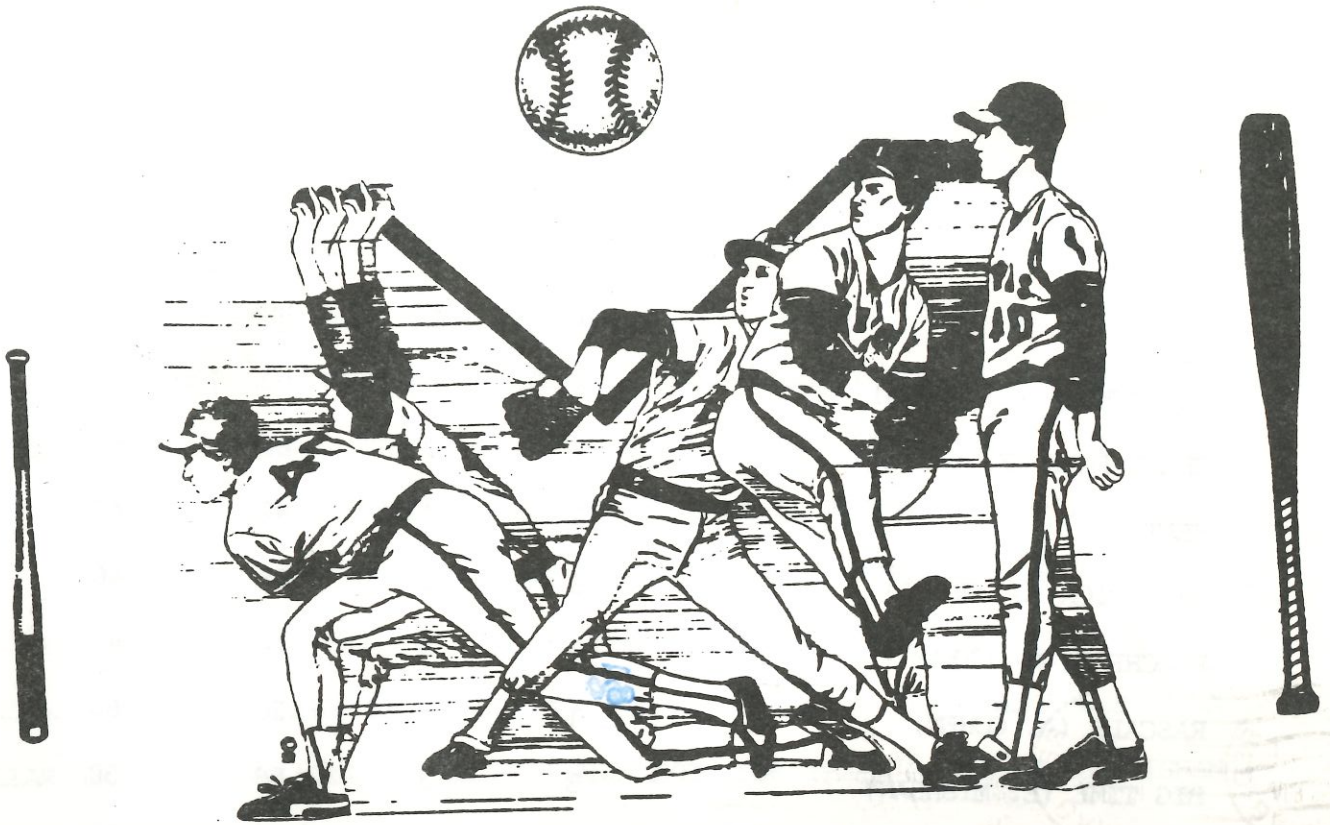
