

HOUSE SELECT



House Select is a team designed for Squirt, Peewees and Bantam players looking for more competition than their House team, without the time and financial commitment of Travel Hockey. Select teams travel 3-4 weekends for the Midwest Hockey League.

COST

Individual player fees will be based on the number of qualified players who make each Select team (will be determined by coaching staff and hockey director). For example, if 14 players make one team, the cost will be the team fee divided by 14. In the past, fees have ranged from \$500-\$700 per player. A payment plan for this fee is available, if needed.

Cost Includes:

- Tryout Fee
- Practice Ice
- 3 Select weekends
- Extra Tournament entry

Cost does not include:

- Travel expenses (hotel, gas, food, etc)



General Information:

- Formed based on tryouts
- Only available for Squirt, PeeWee and Bantam divisions
- Players still play for their house team
- Players will wear their home and away house jerseys, no need to purchase additional uniforms.

Tryout fee is included in team fees.

Practices:

- . Practice is once a week, in addition to their normal House team practice (Normally on Tuesdays, but subject to change - but will not interfere with normal house practice days/times). Each practice will be 60 minutes.

Games:

- . Each team will play approximately 12-16 Select tournament games (in addition to their normal house games).
- . Games will be split up:
 - . Three weekends will be somewhere in the Midwest Affiliate (ex: Des Moines, Omaha, Wichita). There is a chance one of those weekends could be in Kansas City.
 - . Teams will also participate in one additional tournament at the end of the season, the Omaha Stampede or Luck of the Irish.
