FINAL SCORE: BR - 9 TEAM TURMOIL - 7

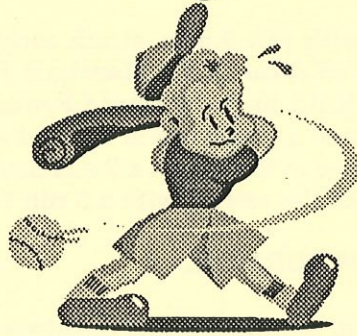
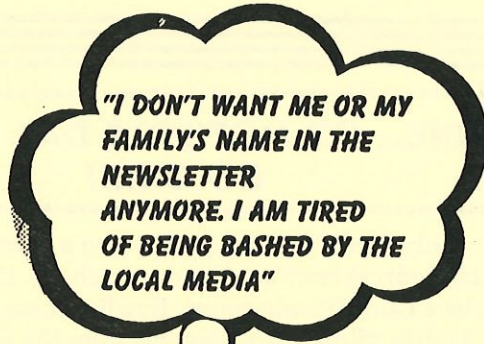
