Teams are awarded three points for each conference win in regulation or 5-on-5 overtime, and one point for a 5-on-5 overtime tie. Conference games still tied after a five-minute 5-on-5 overtime advance to a five-minute 3-on-3 overtime (and sudden victory shootout if still tied) with the team that wins the second overtime/shootout receiving an extra point in the standings (3/SW in the standings), making all games worth three (3) points. The 3-on-3 overtime and shootouts only affect conference standings, while the game is officially a tie for NCAA purposes.

# NCHC FACTS AND FIGURES

CONFERENCE-OPENING CLASHES: After Western Michigan and Colorado College opened conference play last weekend, four more NCHC teams begin conference play this weekend, including a top-10 showdown in Duluth as top-ranked Denver heads to No. 7 Minnesota Duluth in a match-up of the last three national champions. In the other conference series, Miami heads west for two games at No. 10 North Dakota. The Fighting Hawks are 5-0-0 at home this season.

NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: Three NCHC teams face non-conference foes this weekend, with Western Michigan and St. Cloud State facing WCHA foes and Omaha hosting Wisconsin of the Big Ten in a top-20 tilt. NCHC teams are 12-5-4 against WCHA teams this season and a combined 6-6-1 against Big Ten foes. Overall, NCHC teams are a combined 27-15-8 in non-conference play this season, with the .620 win percentage second among the conferences behind only the Big Ten at .641. The NCHC has posted the best combined non-conference winning percentage in four of the last five seasons, including last year (.659) (page 9)

POLL POSITIONS: Four NCHC teams remain ranked in the USCHO. com Poll this week, though there was a newcomer to the poll this week, while three NCHC teams are ranked, all in the top 10, in the USA Hockey Magazine Poll (page 9):

- Omaha entered the USCHO.com Poll at No. 20 for the first time this season, its first ranking since March 19, 2018.
- Denver remained No. 1 in both polls for the fourth straight week and is a unanimous No. 1 in the USA Hockey Magazine Poll for the second straight week.
- North Dakota moved into the top 10 in both polls, as the NCHC's three top-10 teams tie with the Big Ten for the most top-10 teams.
- With the Pioneers still in the top spot, an NCHC team (DU, UMD, SCSU or UND) has now been ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll in 66 of the last 78 weeks dating back to the start of the 2016-17 season.

**DYNAMITE DEFENSE:** Three NCHC teams rank in the top 10 nationally on defense. North Dakota leads the country allowing only 1.43 goals against per game and is also tops the country in fewest shots on goal allowed per game at 17.29 per contest, three fewer than any other team. Two other NCHC teams rank in the top six in defense as well, with Denver giving up only 1.62 goals per game, which ties for third in the NCAA, while Omaha is allowing only 1.83 gpg, ranking sixth in the NCAA. - Colorado College opened conference play last weekend to wrap up a six-game homestand to start the season, but only managed to pick up one point against Western Michigan. On Friday, CC led 3-1, but allowed the final five goals in a 6-3 defeat. Saturday, the Tigers collected a 4-4 overtime tie, but dropped the extra conference point in a shootout. CC last won a shootout Dec. 17, 2017 against Arizona State (4-4 tie) in non-conference play. The Tigers have not won a shootout in conference play since the NCHC adopted the 3-on-3 overtime format in 2015-16.
- Redshirt sophomore forward **Bailey Conger** compiled four points against WMU, including a career-high three points in Saturday's tie, when he scored two goals. It was his second multi-goal game of the season after transferring from Providence last season. Conger had only one goal in 24 games as a freshman at Providence in 2017-18, but already has a team-high-tying four goals this season for the Tigers.

- Denver earned its fourth straight sweep to start the season, taking down Niagara, 6-2, on Friday, and blanking the Purple Eagles, 4-0, on Saturday. With the wins, Denver is 8-0-0 to start the season for only the second time in program history. The Pioneers' best start in program history was a 9-0-0 stretch to start the 2001-02 season. DU will look to tie that record Friday at Minnesota Duluth.
- Sophomore goaltender **Michael Corson** earned his first career shutout on Saturday in his first career start. He made all 16 saves needed to pick up the whitewash, as well as NCHC Goaltender of the Week honors. He had only appeared in one game previously in his career, entering in relief as a freshman, also not allowing a goal.
- Junior captain **Ian Mitchell** leads the Pioneers with 10 points (3g, 7a) after dishing out three assists in Friday's win over Niagara. He ranks tied for second among NCAA defensemen in scoring with 10 points and has points in seven of eight games this season.

• Miami played an exhibition game last Friday, taking down the U.S. U-18 National Team, 4-2, in Oxford. Freshman forward Ryan Savage led the offense with three points on a goal and two assists. If the game counted, it would push MU's unbeaten streak to three games after a tie and win at Colgate two weekends ago.

- Senior captain and forward Gordie Green had an assist on the game-winner in Friday's exhibition win. Although the point doesn't count for his statistics, he is still tied for third in the NCHC with a teamhigh nine points (4g, 5a). Green is now 12 points away from becoming the 53rd player in Miami program history to post 100 career points.
- Miami has killed off 14 of 15 penalties over the past four regular-season games (93.3 percent), after allowing seven goals in 18 power plays (61.1 percent) in the first three contests.

- · Minnesota Duluth was idle last weekend, but earned a sweep of instate rival Minnesota in its last outing two weekends ago. UMD downed the Gophers, 5-2, Oct. 25 in Minneapolis and blanked Minnesota, 2-0, in Duluth a night later. UMD improved to 10-3-2 against Minnesota since conference realignment in 2013-14.
- Senior goaltender **Hunter Shepard** stopped all 21 shots he faced on Oct. 26 against Minnesota to record his first shutout of the season and 16th of his career, extending his NCHC record. The 16 whitewashes are also the most among active NCAA netminders, two more than Cornell's Matthew Galajda (14).
- Freshman forward Brandon Puricelli tallied his first collegiate goal and point in the Oct. 25 win at Minnesota. He then added his first career assist on the game-winning goal the next night. Fellow freshman forward **Quinn Olson** teamed up with Puricelli, as Olson notched his first assist on Puricelli's first goal, while Puricelli set up Olson's first collegiate goal on Oct. 26, as both finished with a goal and an assist in the series.

## Julie & Spencer Penrose Memorial Cup

warded to the NCHC regular season Achampion, the Julie and Spencer Penrose Memorial Cup (right) serves as the league's crowning achievement. The Cup is named after Julie and Spencer Penrose, who were tremendously successful in the business world and did much of it in Colorado Springs in the early 1900s. The couple made much of their money in the copper industry, which is why the trophy includes copper stars on it. The Penroses also set up the El Pomar Foundation, which still today helps pay for amateur sports and other non-profits, including the NCHC office located in the Copper Building next to the Penrose House on the grounds of the Penrose compound in



Colorado Springs. The El Pomar Foundation has also issued grants for the Penrose Cup, medallions for each individual champion and the NCHC's annual Post-Graduate Scholarship. St. Cloud State won its second straight and third Penrose Cup overall last season, also winning it in the NCHC's inaugural season (2013-14). North Dakota has won two Penrose Cups back-to-back (2014-15, 2015-16), while Denver is the only other Penrose Cup champion (2016-17) to date.

#### NCHC Tournament/Frozen Faceoff

he NCHC Tournament will consist of four quarterfinal series on the first weekend following regular-season play (March 13-15, 2020). The four higher seeds will host the four lower seeds in a best two-out-of-three format. Seed #1 will host Seed #8, Seed #2 will host Seed #7, Seed #3 will host Seed #6, and Seed #4 will host Seed #5. The winners of the four quarterfinal series





will advance to the NCHC Frozen Faceoff at Xcel Energy Center in Saint Paul, Minn. for the two semifinal games on Friday, March 20. Semifinal games will be reseeded based on the final regular-season standings. The winners of the two semifinal games (4:08/7:38 p.m. CT) will then meet in the Championship Game (7:38 p.m. CT) on Saturday, March 21 for an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while the two losers from the semifinal games will face each other in the third-place game (3:38 p.m. CT) earlier in the day. The 2018 NCHC Frozen Faceoff, won by Denver, was named Visit Saint Paul's Event of the Year for 2017-18. Minnesota Duluth won the 2019 Frozen Faceoff title, its second NCHC Tournament crown (2017).

#### FRIDAY, NOV. 1

The pursuit of the 2019-20 Penrose Cup officially got underway Friday night as Western Michigan won the first conference game of the season, while three NCHC teams combined to go 1-1-1 in non-conference action and Miami won an exhibition contest.

The Broncos (3-3-1, 1-0-0-0 NCHC) fell behind Colorado College (2-3-0, 0-1-0-0 NCHC), 3-1, but scored the game's final five goals to rally past CC for a 6-3 road win in the first conference contest of the season. WMU scored four goals in the third period to earn the three points, while three different Broncos tallied three points. Sophomore forward Drew Worrad had two goals and an assist, while junior forwards Josh Passolt and Paul Washe each notched a goal and two helpers. WMU also struck twice on the power play and killed all four Tiger man advantages.

Top-ranked Denver (7-0-0) remained perfect on the season with a convincing, 6-2, win over Niagara (0-5-0) at Magness Arena. The Purple Eagles led 2-1 after 20 minutes, but DU struck four times in the second stanza, including three times on the power play. Junior forward Kohen Olischefski tallied two goals, while sophomore forward Brett Stapley dished out a trio of assists for DU. The Pioneers outshot Niagara, 48-16, in the win.

In the late game of the night, Omaha (4-1-1) settled for a 3-3 overtime tie at Alaska Anchorage (1-4-1) in the series finale, after picking up a win on Thursday. The Mavericks led 3-2 in the third period, but the Seawolves scored on the power play with seven minutes to play in regulation to pick up the draw. Sophomore forward Tyler Weiss tallied Omaha's final two goals, both in the second period, for his first career multi-goal game.

After not losing a single home game all of last season, No. 16 St. Cloud State (1-2-2) dropped its second home game this season on Friday, falling to Princeton (1-0-0), 5-3. The Tigers scored twice in each of the first two periods, while two of the SCSU's three goals came on the power play. Sophomore forward Sam Hentges had a hand in all three SCSU goals with a tally and two assists, extending his point streak to five games to start the season.

In exhibition action, Miami returned home and downed the U.S. U-18 National Team, 4-2, in Oxford. Junior forward Casey Gilling scored the game-winner midway through the third period on the power play to break a 2-2 tie, while the RedHawks added an empty-netter to seal the win. Freshman forward Ryan Savage notched a goal and two assists in the exhibition win.

#### SATURDAY, NOV. 2

Of the five National Collegiate Hockey Conference (NCHC) teams in action Saturday night, none of them came away with a loss, as two earned wins and three settled for ties, including the lone conference game Saturday. Western Michigan and Colorado College skated to an entertaining 4-4 overtime tie, before the Broncos bagged the extra standings point in a shootout. Top-ranked Denver blanked Niagara, 4-0, to complete a sweep and remain perfect on the season, while No. 14/14 North Dakota stayed perfect at home with a 3-1 win over Michigan Tech in the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Game. Elsewhere, No. 16 St. Cloud State played to a back-and-forth 5-5 overtime tie with Princeton.

After Western Michigan (3-3-2, 1-0-1-1 NCHC) rallied for a win on Friday, the Broncos once again used a comeback to collect two points at Colorado College (2-3-1, 0-1-1-0 NCHC) Saturday as the teams tied 4-4. The Tigers scored twice in the second period to take a 4-3 lead, but freshman defenseman Ronnie Attard tallied his second goal of the night, for his first multi-goal game, with 24 seconds remaining in regulation to pull WMU even with an extra attacker. After scoreless 5-on-5 and 3-on-3 overtimes, the Broncos won the sudden-death shootout in the second round after both shooters converted in round one. Redshirt sophomore forward Bailey Conger paced CC's offense with two goals and an assist, while junior forward Ethen Frank dished out three helpers for WMU, which took five of six points on the weekend.

Top-ranked Denver (8-0-0) remained perfect on the season with a 4-0 blanking of Niagara (0-6-0), capping a weekend sweep. The Pioneers outshot the Purple Eagles, 47-16, but didn't find the back of the net until junior forward Jake Durflinger tallied the game-winner in the second period. Sophomore forward Brett Stapley then tacked on a short-handed goal in the third period to make it 2-0, while DU added two empty-netters late to seal the win. Sophomore goalie Michael Corson earned his first career shutout with a 16-save performance.

For the second straight year, No. 14/14 North Dakota (5-1-1) won the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Game, knocking off Michigan Tech (3-4-0), 3-1, in Grand Forks. The Huskies struck first, but UND answered soon after in the first period. Junior forward Jordan Kawaguchi then broke the deadlock midway through the third period with the game-winning goal on a wrister in the slot, while UND tacked on an empty-netter to cap the win. The Fighting Hawks outshot MTU, 24-15, in the victory.

In a wild, back-and-forth affair, No. 16 St. Cloud State (1-2-3) held one-goal leads on three separate occasions, but each time Princeton (1-0-1) fought back as the Huskies had to settle for a 5-5 overtime tie in the series finale at the Herb Brooks National Hockey Center. Three of the five SCSU goals came on the power play, including one each from sophomore forward Sam Hentges and junior forward Easton Brodzinski, putting the Huskies in front each time. Hentges extended his point streak to six games to start the season with an assist, as well, while Brodzinski led the way with three points on a goal and two helpers. Corey Andonovski tallied a hat trick for the Tigers, including tying the game on the power play with less than seven minutes left in regulation.
