IN-PERSON CLINICIAN POLICY

North Country Region provides professionally trained officials as clinicians to facilitate In-Person Officiating Clinics for our North Country Region – USA Volleyball member clubs. Those interested in taking on the role of an In-Person Clinician must meet the following minimum requirements:

- North Country Region Provisional Referee Training Certification
- Two years officiating experience
- Participation in On-Court Training with a member of the North Country Region Officiating Training Team within the past year (Provisional and Regional officials)
- Completion of the In-Person Clinic Officiating Training Seminar taking place at the North Country Region Fall Huddle*

*Beginning the 2020-2021 season

Club Directors/Coaches as Clinicians

In the event that a certified USAV Official is not available OR at the specific request of a club, a club director and/or experienced coach may be approved to facilitate the In-Person Clinic.

- Gold Medal Club Qualification
 - Club director submits Officiating Clinic lesson plan to North Country Region for approval.
 - Club director verifies (signs-off) that he/she or an experienced coach taught the officiating clinic.
 - Club director verifies (signs-off) that he/she and all coaches and players successfully completed the training.
- Non-Gold Member Club Qualification
 - Club director verifies (signs-off) that he/she or an experienced coach taught the officiating clinic.
 - Club director verifies (signs-off) that he/she and all coaches and players successfully completed the training.
