Covid 19 Rules & Recommendations

- Any players, coaches, fans cannot come to the game if you have any symptoms.
- Teams must follow 6ft social distancing guidelines at all times. If players cannot do this in their dugout players must bring chairs or sit in the stands.
- Spectators/fans are strongly discouraged .
- Games must be limited to groups of 25 or less. This does not include umpires, coaches, and managers.
- Each team must provide their own baseballs while on defense.
- Snap a photo of opposing teams lineup card.
- No sharing of any equipment or drinks.
- No spitting, chewing tobacco, or sunflower seeds allowed at all fields.
- No groups congregating before or after any games. This is at the field or in the parking lots.
- No handshakes, fist bumps, etc.
- Immediately leave the field after the game.
- Players and Coaches are asked to bring hand sanitizer with them to the field.
- All players must have a signed waiver on file.
- No fans currently allowed at Long Lake Ranch Park!

STATE WIDEMASK MANDATE

Field rules and Guidelines

- Face masks must be worn entering and exiting the facility, field, court etc.
- Leagues and tournaments can continue
- Players participating actively can remove face mask while playing
- Face masks and physical distancing maintained while on sidelines, bench or dugout
- Players/teams must wear a mask if they cannot social distance at all times while not on the field.
- Facemask must be worn leaving field, court or other and leaving the facility
