In order to participate in the CMFL, parents of players are required to review, sign and acknowledge this league code of conduct.

**Central Maine Football League board is made up of volunteers and coaches for each program and are volunteering their time and knowledge of the sport of football to help your children learn the game and develop the skills necessary to play. Please show them your appreciation by being respectful, patient and courteous.**

- Players and parents are expected to represent their own communities and CMFL in a positive manner by displaying good sportsmanship and respect towards coaches, peers, officials and opponents at all times.
  - Parents will be positive role models for all players and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
  - A player's parent/guardian that invites other family members or friends to be spectators are responsible to address any inappropriate conduct of their guests.
  - Parents or other family members who have concerns during a game should address those concerns with their own program director/coach at the end of any contest and let their own director/coach decide the best course of action.
- Bullying **will not be tolerated** on any level including through social media.
- Arguing with officials will not be tolerated. Communication should be between coaches and officials and done in a respectful manner.
- Profanity and unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. When attending games, it is expected for all involved to support their teams and to avoid using profanity and unsportsmanlike comments.
- Use of property: Take care of your belongings, including food and trash.
  - Pets are not allowed on school/athletic facilities.
- Use of tobacco products (including vaping), marijuana & alcohol are not allowed on school/athletic facilities. Drug/smoking/alcohol paraphernalia will be confiscated by program directors.

I have read and understand that myself and any family/friend who comes to practices or games are expected to follow the above code of conduct. I understand that if any of these expectations are violated that it could result in suspension of one or more games.
