



NCCYHA STEELERS ANNOUNCE REGISTRATION FOR THE 2021 - 2022 HOCKEY SEASON

NCCYHA registration begins June 13, 2021. Registration forms and links are located at nccyha.com.

NEW HOCKEY PLAYERS:

Learn to Play Hockey is an introductory hockey skills & skating program. There will be more posted on the Learn to Skate program at a later date. This program is designed for new players or players with only 1 year of hockey experience that want to learn to play hockey. Hockey helmet and skates will be provided. Knee pads and gloves are recommended. Limited equipment packages are available.

Step 1: Complete NCCYHA Registration Form (form located on the league website nccyha.com)

Step 2: Pay \$70 Learn to Play Hockey Fee

IF PLAYER MOVES INTO THE HOUSE LEAGUE, ADDITIONAL REGISTRATION WILL BE REQUIRED.

- USA HOCKEY REGISTRATION (on-line registration required)
- On-line registration with NCCYHA site (nccyha.com)
- Copy of birth certificate

NCCYHA House/MOHL Programs for new players (8U (Mites), 10U (Squirts), 12U (Peewee), 14U (Bantam))

Step 1: Complete USA Hockey: All players and coaches must be registered with USA Hockey. To register, go to usahockey.com, complete the appropriate form, pay the fee and provide a copy of the print form with your NCCYHA registration forms. *Note: No fee for players 6 & under – 2015 birth year and younger but you must compete the USA Hockey registration!*

NCCYHA REGISTRATION FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE USA HOCKEY FORM ATTACHED, EMAILED or PRINT

Step 2: Complete NCCYHA Registration form

Step 3: Provide a Copy of Birth Certificate (hospital birth form is not acceptable)

Step 4: Complete USA Hockey Consent to Treat form and Code of Conduct form

ON-LINE REGISTRATION:

New players can complete all registration forms on our SportsEngine on-line system. See returning hockey player information below. All refunds will be sent out at the end of the season with proof of expense within a survey on our registration page. RETURNING HOCKEY PLAYERS:

ON-LINE REGISTRATION: All on-line links are located on nccyha.com.

NCCYHA has contracted with Sportsengine to assist us with hockey registration and fee collection. The on-line system of registration is simple and convenient. You must have a credit or debit card to use the on-line process.

Step 1: Complete USA Hockey Registration: **All players and coaches** must be registered with USA Hockey to register with NCCYHA go to usahockey.com, complete the appropriate form, pay the fee. You will use the USA Hockey number to complete the Sportsengine registration process.

Step 2: Visit nccyha.com to complete your registration process. All fees listed below will be applied on-line during registration and must be paid with credit or debit card

- Pay registration in full
- Payment plan. 4 Payments, deposit registration and payments on September 1, 2021, October 1, 2021 and November 1, 2021. * - Each monthly payment will include a service fee.

2021-2022 Registration Fees:

- \$70 Learn To Play Hockey
- \$495 8U
- \$650 HOUSE: 10U, 12U and 14U (House and MOHL)

2021-2022 Registration Rebates:

- \$70 Rebate mailed to NEW players registered for Learn To Play Hockey participant that joins NCCYHA House league (8U – 14U)
- \$44 Reimbursement for a coach registering with USA Hockey will be given at the end of the Season completion of coaches reimbursement survey.

Coaches must register with USA Hockey, attend a USA Hockey Coaching Course (keep coaching card current), must keep current with all appropriate Age Specific Modules (U8, U10, U12, 14U) , Complete Safe Sport training (every two years) and complete mandatory screening (every two years).
