

Lower Cape Bluefins Season Football Volunteer Policy

As we gear up for an exciting Bluefins season, we are grateful for your continued support and dedication to our team. Our success on and off the field is greatly attributed to the collaborative efforts of our parents and volunteers.

To ensure the smooth operation of our football games and to support the needs of our athletes, we rely on the generous assistance of parent volunteers. However, we understand that everyone's schedule and commitments vary, and we respect your time constraints.

In an effort to make volunteer work more equitable for the entire program, a \$100 DEPOSIT per family will be required. A check made payable to Lower Cape Bluefins in the amount of \$100, will be held as a deposit by the organization until family volunteer requirements have been completed. The volunteer check will be destroyed at the end of the season provided that volunteer requirements have been completed. The deposit check WILL NOT BE CASHED unless your family does not satisfy the volunteer requirements. Your deposit needs to be received by the organization before your participant can receive equipment. The \$100 volunteer deposit check must be turned in at equipment issue.

Who can volunteer?

Any family member who is at least 18 years of age can volunteer for any Bluefins event to satisfy the family volunteer requirement. NO volunteers or children of volunteers under the age of 18 are allowed in the announcer booth or snack shack. NO volunteers under the age of 18 can work the chain gang for games.

Volunteer Fee Opt-out Donation

Bluefins require a \$100 donation if your family chooses not to volunteer for any organization events during the season. This fee is payable at the time of registration via credit card. Once you opt-out your family will not be required to volunteer for any events during the season.

What are the volunteer requirements?

Families are required to complete 2 volunteer shifts at LCB events throughout each season. Generally speaking, each team will have a set amount of volunteer shifts assigned based on the number of home games and the organization's needs. It is the parent's responsibility to find a replacement or trade with another parent for a shift, if they cannot make it. The volunteer replacement can be anyone at least 18 years old. If a family member fails to show up for an assigned shift that family risks forfeiting the \$100 volunteer deposit check if no other volunteer opportunities exist.
