

**District 2 Rules Meeting
Sunday, August 29th 2021**

President Hursh called the meeting to order at 7:24PM at Roma's on Sunday, August 29th, 2021.

MVI motions to approve the annual meeting minutes, Chisago Lake seconds. **Minutes approved.**

MVI motions to approve by-law changes through consent agenda as presented. Chisago Lakes seconds. By-law changes are approved and the motion carries.

6.1- D2 Playoff/End of Year tournament length of Game Format

6.1A)- Bantam AA/A: 3-17 minute stopped time periods (2-hour ice time) **FAIL**

6.1B)- Bantam B1/B2/C: 3-15 minute stopped time periods (1.5-hour ice time) **PASS**

6.1C)- Peewee AA/A/B1/B2/C: 3-15 minute stopped time periods (1.5-hour ice time) **PASS**

3.1.7- Bantam AA/A- 2 ice hour periods to play games (120 minutes includes resurface) **FAIL**

A) Head coaches and Referees must agree on the actual start time of the game and record that time on the score sheet.

B) 8-minute pre-game warm up starting once both teams are on the ice.

C) The length of time for all 3 periods is 17 minutes stop time. (See F below for exception)

D) All games start on fresh ice and resurface after the second period.

E) 2 minute warm up before the start of the third period, starting once both teams have returned to the ice.

F) Running time will be used whenever a 6-goal differential occurs in the third period. (If the goal differential becomes less 5 or less, stop time shall begin again.) During running time, the time clock will be stopped when a penalty is reported to the MINOR OFFICIALS to enter penalty time. Running time will resume at the drop of the puck. If an injury occurs during running time, the clock will stop ONLY at the discretion of the referee.

G) The time between periods where there is no resurface is 1 minute.

H) Game termination: a game is ended when any of the following occurs:

- 1) Completion of period 3 if there is a goal differential between the teams.
- 2) At the end of the (1) 5-minute stop time sudden victory overtime period if neither team has scored in the overtime period.
- 3) When either team scores during the sudden victory overtime period.
- 4) The end of the agreed upon (2) ice hours. In this case, a game may be ended with time remaining on the game clock.
- 5) Arena has rights to terminate game based on length.

NOTE: Bantam "A" or "AA" League games will be allowed to play (1) 5-minute stop time sudden victory overtime period if the score is tied at the end of 3 periods of regulation play.

I) A game is considered complete after the completion of 2 full periods of play and the time limit for the game has expired. Any game, in which 2 full periods have not been completed before the ice hours have expired, will not be considered a complete game. The game will be rescheduled and played as a new game with 0 to 0 score. Both teams will share cost of new game.

J) Each team is allowed 1-minute time-out during the game.

K) End of year tournaments/District play off: Bantam AA/A: 3-17 minute stopped time periods (2-hour ice time)

**This entire rule was as one vote.*

Rule 3.1.6c- Running time in third period be changed from the current 6 goal deficit to 5 goals. **FAIL**

Rule 3.1.6d- U10 and U12 period length to change from 13 minutes to 12 minutes. **PASS**

Rule 3.16- Pre-game warmup to be changed from existing 5 minutes to 4 minutes in duration. Home team should provide warm-up pucks for all games. For tournaments, the host team shall provide warm-up pucks. **FAIL**

Rule 3.3.7- If a parent or spectator is removed from the rink that team's head coach be suspended for their team's next game. **FAIL**

Rule 1.2.4- Allow the game clock to be used for mite scrimmages ONLY for shift change purposes, NOT to keep score. **PASS**

Rule 6.1- Allow end of the year district playoffs to have a double elimination for non-region bound teams. **FAIL**

Rule 6.1- **there were three different options and are labeled as a, b and c.*

a) Allow end of the year district playoffs for non-region bound teams to be double elimination-

FAIL

b) All Bantam Cs, PeeWee Cs, Squirts and 10Us teams be included in end of year tournaments that are single elimination. **PASS**

c) stays as is- top 8 teams play in single elimination- **FAIL**
