ALL CAPS

LAST GAME - CHICAGO: The Chicago Steel defeated the Cedar Rapids RoughRiders 3-2 Friday night at Fox Valley Ice Arena. The Steel extended their current point streak to five straight games with the victory. Chicago has not lost in regulation on home ice with a 7-0-1-0 mark. The Steel went 0-for-4 (0.0%) on the power play and posted a perfect 2-for-2 (100%) night on the penalty kill. Cedar Rapids outshot the Steel 33-24. Steel forward Nick Moldenhauer tallied his first career USHL goal while Luke Levandowski picked up his first marker of the season. Sam Lipkin registered the game-winning goal, becoming just the sixth player in the league to reach the double-digit mark in goals this season. Netminder Gibson Homer made 31 saves, his seventh game with 30 or more stops, and now has a 5-1-4-0 record between the Steel pipes this season.

LAST GAME - MADISON: The Capitols fell 4-2 against the Youngstown Phantoms on Friday at Bob Suter's Capitol Ice Arena in Wisconsin. Madison couldn't complete the comeback as the Phantoms scored the game's three goals before the Capitols cut the deficit to 3-2 in the final frame. The Capitols outshot the Phantoms 35-30 in the loss while going 2-for-7 (28.6%) on the power play. Madison's penalty kill went 3-for-5 (60.0%) on the night. The Caps were led by Tyler Haskins who factored in on both markers with a goal and an assist while Nick DeSantis accounted for his seventh marker of the year. Simon Latkoczy made 26 saves in the loss.

AGAINST THE CAPITOLS: Chicago owns a 26-7-3-0 record in franchise history against the Capitols, including a 13-3-1-0 mark on home ice. The Steel fell 3-2 in overtime against the Capitols on Oct. 1 at Bob Suter's Capitol Ice Arena in the first of 10 scheduled matchups between the Eastern Conference foes this season.

OUTSHOT, NEVER OUTMANNED: Through 18 games played, the Steel have outshot their opponent in just three contests thus far, posting a perfect 3-0-0-o record in those games, all on home ice. When the opponent is credited with more shots, the Steel have a 9-2-2-0 record, one of just two teams in the Eastern conference with a winining record in games being outshout (min. five games).

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING: Steel rookie Nick Moldenhauer tallied his first career marker in the USHL in Friday's 3-2 victory over Cedar Rapids. This season, six total skaters have scored their first goal for Chicago.

MADISON MEN: The Capitols are one of four teams in the USHL to reach the double-digit mark in wins thus far during the 2021-2022 campaign. Madison leads the league with 36.2 shots per game and sits in first as the highest-scoring team in the USHL with 4.33 markers per game.
