

Hello BYHA Families!

With clinics for all travel levels starting soon, I wanted to send out some reminders for DIBS and requirements for Locker Room Monitors (LRM). If you have questions or need further information, please view the tryout page on the BYHA website or contact me via email.

All Team Managers, Locker Room Monitors, Board Members, Coordinators, and any volunteer that will have regular contact with or authority over BYHA players are required to complete the following registration steps.

Game day volunteers for penalty box, clock and scorekeeping are not required to register.

Locker Room Monitor

Locker room monitors need to be registered with USA Hockey, have an up-to-date SafeSport certification, and a valid background check on file with BYHA. Get those things done ASAP if you want to help with this year's tryouts as a locker room monitor.

If you sign up for a LRM spot and do not have the above completed prior to the shift, you will not receive credit for the DIBS hours.

Lobby registration for tryouts

Two volunteers will arrive before tryouts to make sure jerseys are hung and ready to hand out to players as they check-in. Jerseys will be handed out 30 minutes prior to the start of the tryout time. Locker rooms will not be available until 30 minutes prior to the start of a tryout **AND** if

there is a LRM present for the locker room. After the tryout, check in the jerseys from players so they can be washed and ready for the next use.

Can I get the jersey washing DIBS?

They go quickly! The time listed in DIBS is when the jerseys would be available for washing. There is no place to wash them at the rink. They will need to be washed/dried and returned to the hangers in the rink lobby prior to the next morning. It is possible that we need some returned the same day on the weekends for use at a later tryout that day.

When you arrive for a tryout DIBS position...

There is a check-in process posted on the board to the right of the vending machine in the lobby. Scan the QR code and complete the form when you arrive for your DIBS shift for clinics/tryouts. Again, if you work a LRM shift and have not completed the process above, you will not receive credit for the shift.

Tryout DIBS have been posted so grab the ones you want! All the volunteers are what make this process work, and we appreciate each and every one of you!
