### Membership Type Descriptions

**Home Club:** Skaters that belong only to SFFSC or who consider SFFSC their primary club if they belong to another club and will be skating ISI only with SFFSC.

**Home Club + USFS:** Skaters that belong only to SFFSC or who consider SFFSC their primary club if they belong to another club and will be skating USFS or USFS & ISI with SFFSC.

**Secondary Club:** Skaters that identify another club as their primary club and will be skating ISI only with SFFSC.

**Secondary Club + USFS:** Skaters that identify another club as their primary club and will be skating USFS or USFS & ISI with SFFSC.

**Intro:** This is a discounted rate for the first year of USFS membership.

**Collegiate:** Four-year membership for skaters attending college.

**ISI Membership:** Registration is the responsibility of the skater (skater's family) through skater's personal account and is paid directly to ISI at the time of registration. Membership year is Sept 1 through Aug 31 of the following year.

**USFS Membership:** Registration is managed through SFFSC club account and is paid to SFFSC at the time of registration. Membership year is July 1 through June 31 of the following year.

Questions about which skating organization (ISI, USFS, or both) a skater should belong to is a decision that is made between the skater, skater family, and the skater's private lesson coach.

## Volunteer Requirements

Home Club Member	16	\$200	If skater participates in show: 2 hrs required @ that event. If skater participates in competition: 6 hrs required @ that event. At least 4 hours must be met by playing music for FS ice.
Secondary Home Club Member	10	\$100	If skater participates in show: 2 hrs required @ that event. If skate participates in competition: 6 hrs required @ that event. At least 2 hours must be met by playing music for FS ice.
Home Club Collegiate Member	0	n/a	No volunteering required, but always welcome. If skater participates in a competition or show you are encouraged to volunteer 1 shift at that event.

Volunteering as a Committee Chair or Co-Chairing a Committee completes your volunteer requirement.

Board service or bake sale participation does not count toward required hours.

Checks will be collected from members and if hours aren't met, they will be cashed following the last event of the season.
