

## Auburn Hockey Club (AHC) Guidelines

- Players, Coach and Volunteer will need to complete the \*\*\*Visiting Team Health Screening Questionnaire\*\*\*.
  - This link will be put onto the [Auburn Icehawks](#) website
  - Players cannot participate in games unless this form is complete
- Masks are mandatory for every person entering the building on and off the ice – player or coach, home or away
  - Please pack extra masks for if /when they get wet or soggy
- Players, Coaches and 2 SPECTATORS per player are allowed in the building
  - When entering, the process will be:
    - temp taken at door by AHC or Away team volunteer
    - proceed to check in table
    - signs will be posted for seating assignment
    - Spectators must maintain social distancing
  - Bathrooms in the LOBBY are available for use for all teams.
- Designated volunteers from the AHC home team are:
  - Score keeper
  - Clock
  - 2 people for running penalty boxes (Safesport, volunteer USA Hockey # required)
  - Check in – home and visitor
  - Volunteers are asked to be a parent of a AHC Player on the team playing
  - Teams will manage rotation of their volunteers

- Visiting teams will need to provide the AHC Staff with the following information:
  - AHC Contact Tracing Team Form (Auburn Hockey Club Website)
  - The check in volunteer will use this information to check the AWAY team in as they enter Casey Park, form will be submitted to AHC volunteer for records and contact tracing purposes (Temps taken)
- Players, Coaches, spectators and Refs Allowed in 15 min before game
- Game running volunteers are Allowed in 30 min before game
- After completion of the game, please exit the facility within 10 minutes
- After the game is done, the AHC volunteers for that game are responsible for sanitizing
  - Home and away seats that kids sat in before and after game.
- HOME and AWAY players must arrive fully dressed
  - Goalie exception – Goalies can dress at their designated seats
- Coaches will be responsible for players remaining socially distanced in their seats until game start
- Game ends at end of scheduled timeframe due to needing to remain on schedule
  - Games will go to running time if needed.
- The AHC board is working EVERYDAY to get alignment with the County/City/State for more spectators. We will update the membership as quickly as we have updates.
- Mites 8U:
  - The following volunteers are needed per game:
    - Clock runner
    - Check in verification
    - Team Manager
  - All rules above apply to this group with the exception below (ONLY 8U)
    - 2 Spectator per family (home and away)
    - Spectators will be required to social distance at all times
    - The purpose of this rule is to help keep our young players SAFE and in compliance with all rules above and to help with equipment
