

RICHMOND GENERALS SELECT TEAM TRYOUTS

The Generals Select team program is a complement to the House League program for players who are seeking additional practices and the opportunity to participate in competitive tournaments at a lower cost and with less travel demands than a typical travel team.

All players who participate in Selects also play House. In addition to their 20 game House season, a player who chooses to play Selects will receive an additional practice per week (20 Select practices per season) and play in 5 tournaments (typically 20-22 games per season) in places such as Washington DC, Philadelphia, and North Carolina.

In addition, beginning with the 2019-2020 season, all Select teams will play 2 home games in Richmond.

Tryout details for the 2019-20 Richmond Generals Select Teams have been set. Registration is \$40 per player (see link <https://www.richmondgenerals.com/selectstryouts>) and entries will only be accepted online.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE SELECT PROGRAM

PRICE?

TEAM SIZE?

The teams are budgeted for 15 skaters and two goalies.

SELECT PRACTICES?

Days and times have yet to be selected.

HOUSE PRACTICES?

Select players also practice once per week with their House teams in a modified ADM format that places similar skilled players together

SELECT TOURNAMENTS?

Each Select team will play a minimum of 5 tournaments (typically 20-22 games per season) in places such as Washington DC, Philadelphia, and North Carolina. Tournaments are typically held on holiday weekends in October, December, January, February and then in mid-March.

SELECT TEAM GAMES IN RICHMOND?

Each Select Team will play two home games this season. Select teams do not travel for league games.

HOUSE GAMES?

Instead of practice scrimmages, Select players also compete with their teams in the Richmond Generals House League. House games are scheduled on weekends when Select teams are not at tournaments. Teams are evenly balanced to ensure competitive games. Games are full length, including Referees and a Scorekeeper. There are typically 24 House Practices and 20 House Games to augment the Select season.

LEVEL OF COMPETITION?

All tournaments desire to have competitive games against balanced teams. Accordingly, tournament directors will assign teams to appropriate divisions at the tournament based on the strength of teams and their records. This is true for all travel teams. Last season, Generals Select teams played tournaments in B and A divisions.

PLAYING TIME?

Every Select player can expect a regular shift.

MULTIPLE KIDS?

For the convenience of families with multiple players and friends on other teams, all Select teams practice on the same night, play in the same tournaments, and stay at the same hotel throughout the season.

NUMBER OF SELECT TEAMS?

Squirt, PeeWee, Bantam field two teams per age group. Mites and Midgets plan to field one team this season.
