1. Meeting called to order at 7:07pm
2. Consent Agenda approved

**OLD BUSINESS**

1. October Board Meeting Minutes reviewed and approved for posting.

**NEW BUSINESS**

2. October Treasury Report reviewed and approved
3. BAC Coordination – Carrie W is leaving her position with BAC, and new secretary/admin is taking over. They are working to approved enrollment in all sports. Chris/Ken will work to continue to attend the BAC meetings.
4. Website Info Updates – Website has been updated with 2025-26 winter programming dates and links to registration. U9-10 and U11-12 tryout dates have been posted and registration is open for those programs.
5. Updates from DOC/Technical Director- Status Updates  
Board positions available were posted in the newsletter that Akin sent out recently. Skills training has started with good enrollment at younger ages. U16 NPL team has begun training for winter season. We are still accepting players at several older age groups. Brian Nacey brought the idea of adding a U18/19 boys team for players coming over from high school season, which could start in spring. This would have a different price point, since no winter training, possibly not playing league. Would aim for this to be cost neutral.
6. AGM – We are looking for new board member volunteers for several positions. Email and social media posts have been distributed. Discussed making volunteer terms 2 years (verses the current 3 years). This would require by-law changes, which we could take care of by holding a special AGM as needed. This change would require a 60 day notice to membership, per current by-laws.

Motion made to amend the bylaws to change from 3 year term to 2 year term for directors and hold a vote on that motion 60 days after posting that proposed change. This would be done via a special

AGM held 60 days after posting. Motion passed. Minutes to November meeting will be distributed to board members at conclusion of meeting to approve for posting.

7. Director Reports

- Recreational – Discussed whether BVU can support having recreational teams at the middle school age group. Lack of registration numbers on the girls' side, and question of finding coaching to send 1-2 teams to Eagan/EVAA leagues are barriers. For Fall season, this seems to be an easy decision to not offer, as middle school soccer is an option for most kids. For Spring season, we can look at numbers as registration goes, and make timely decision to have team or not, so players can find place at a different organization. Discussed possibility of adding a small stipend for a coach for this group, or recruiting a travel coach to take on the role.
