Minute Approval: Troy motioned to approve the minutes. Courtney seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Troy

Things are looking good. We have not received any ice fee bills yet from the city. That is a significant portion of our budget. We have \$54,000 in the bank right now.

Old Business

1. Tournament Review

Scott wanted to thank Melanie for all of her work with coordinating the refs through the tournaments. Things have gone well for all three tournaments. The feedback has been overwhelmingly positive. We also talked about ensuring all families volunteer to help during a tournament weekend. We would like to think about starting a requirement for a certain number of games each family must help with. We could charge people if they don't help or we could say if you don't help your kid doesn't play. We'll discuss this more in the summer.

New Business:

2. Incident Form-Alyssa

Alyssa has made the incident form electronic and we have added it to the website. It only goes to Mike and Scott. This is not for Safe Sport reporting, only local association issues. Alyssa will edit it to include a link to the SafeSport reporting in case someone is looking for it.

3. Nominations and Elections

Alyssa will send everything to Kelli and she will get the emails sent out. Dan will oversee nominations and elections and Kelli can assist.

4. Scheduler E-mail

Alyssa would like to create a scheduler email address so all communication can go from that one email address. Troy and Kelli will work on getting the Google account switched over to the non-profit status account so we can have multiple emails under it.

5. Bylaw edits

Troy is wondering how we work on smoother transitions with the scheduler and registrar positions. He is suggesting we consider having a scheduler/registrar elect person elected in the off-year. They would not have a vote until the "in office" person was officially done.

Alyssa also said that in another association, they vote for new board members in January and they begin their service in March/April. This gives a couple of months of transition time when preparing to make a change.

We also talked about moving our board meetings to the 1st Tuesday of the month. This would allow our members to go to the city council meetings which are held on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday.

We are aiming for March 25th to host our Annual Meeting. Troy will work on a location for this.

6. Team Gifts/Party

We approve up to \$50 per player on gifts/party for the end of the year. If teams didn't get a chance to use their team building money we will allow that to be rolled into this.

7. Team Pictures

Michelle will remain off ice. She can choose if she takes them off ice or shoots through the door. Ryan will touch base with her.
