GBS coaches will serve as “guest bartenders” and all “tips” will benefit the Booster Club. The event is free to attend.

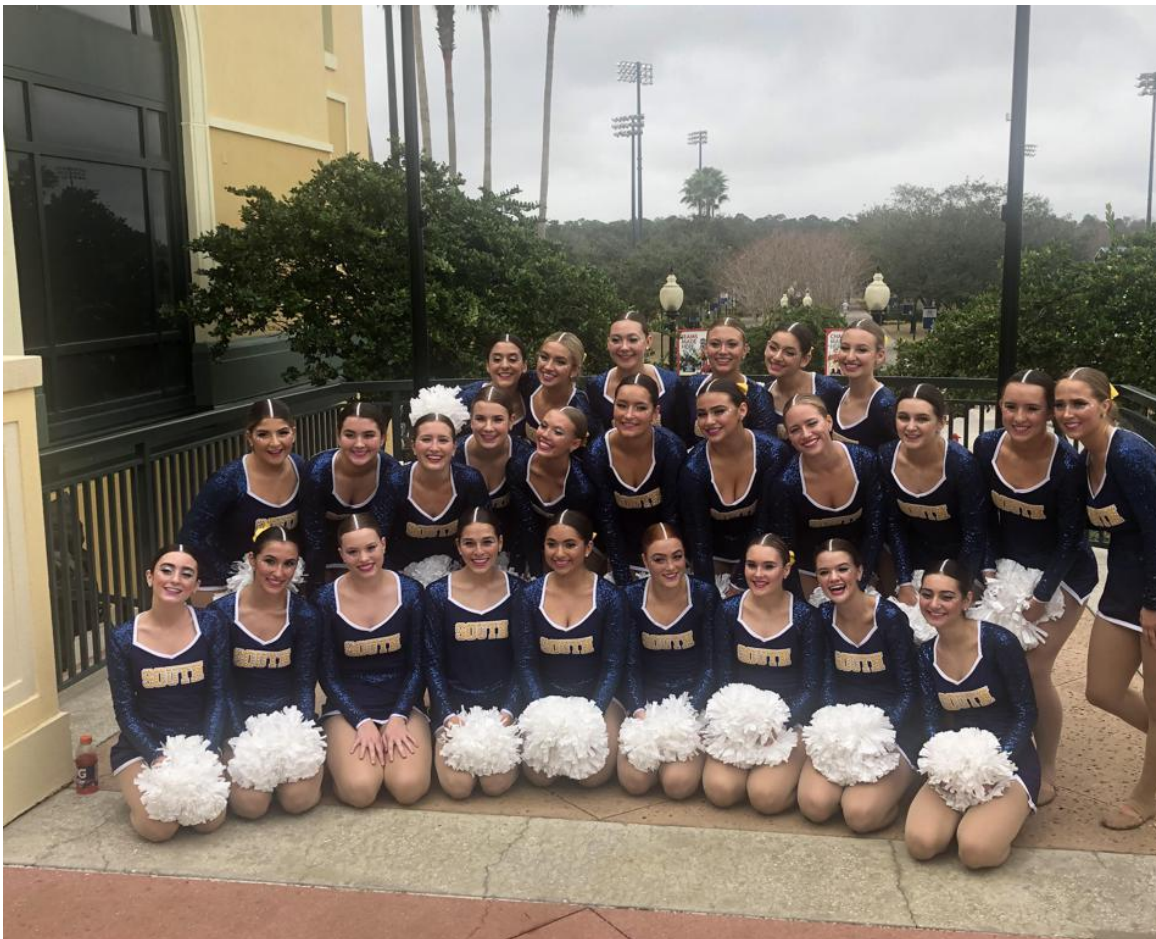

Boys Basketball

The Boys Basketball team lost to New Trier Friday night in Wilmette, 57-45 in front of a packed house of Titan and Trevian fans.

The Titans were challenged by New Trier's size inside.

"The game plan is always to stop the 6-9 kids," Glenbrook South coach Phil Ralston told the Glenview Lantern. "Whether you can do that or not is another thing.

"I think we had a good game plan, it was really at our pace in the first half. Defensively, we tried to take away as many perimeter shots as we could, but still we gave them too many open shots."

"We played defense better the last game. I didn't think our defense here late was what we wanted it to be," Glenbrook South coach Phil Ralston said. "If I could have three of those possessions back again, a transition basket that got taken away from us, a couple different calls go a different way, maybe it's a bit tighter game."

Dom Martinelli and Mac Hubbard led GBS. The two combined for 35 of the Titans' 45 points.

The boys rebounded with a victory over Maine East, 62-38.

Dominic Martinelli had a game high 28 point and seven rebounds. Tyler Nelson came off the bench and scored an important seven points.

On Tuesday, just before the Polar Vortex set in, the Titans beat Prospect, 60-52, in the Titan Dome.

The Titans travel on Tuesday to Hersey for a 7 p.m. game in Arlington Heights.

4:45 – Registration (Use Auditorium doors labeled "O" across from Football Stadium off of Lake Ave. parking lot)

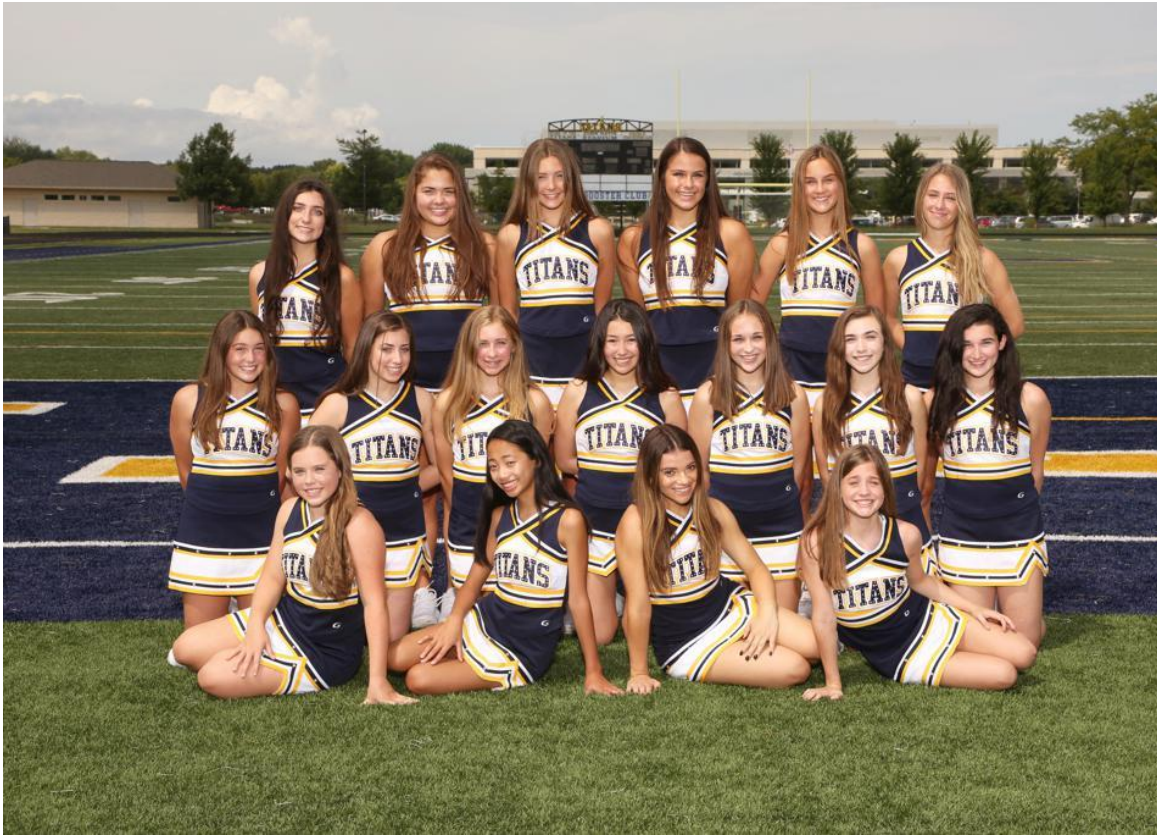
5:00 – Event begins: warm-ups, learn dances, pizza dinner at 6:15

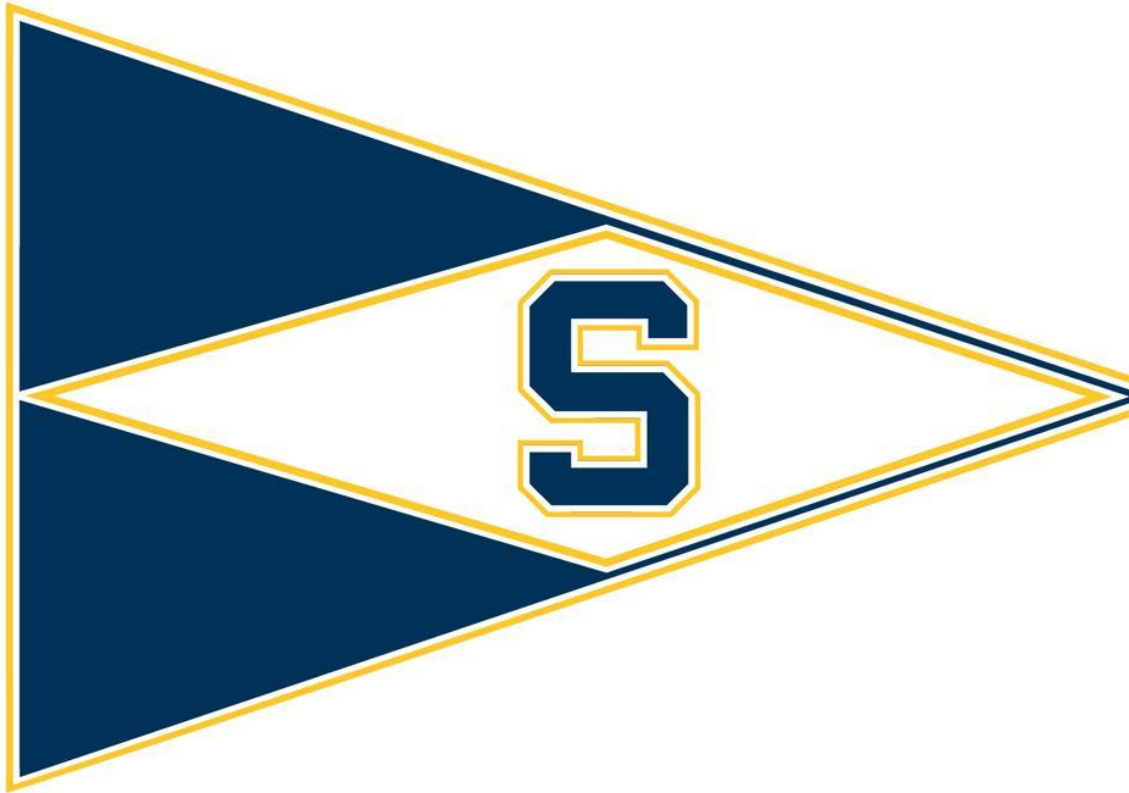
Track

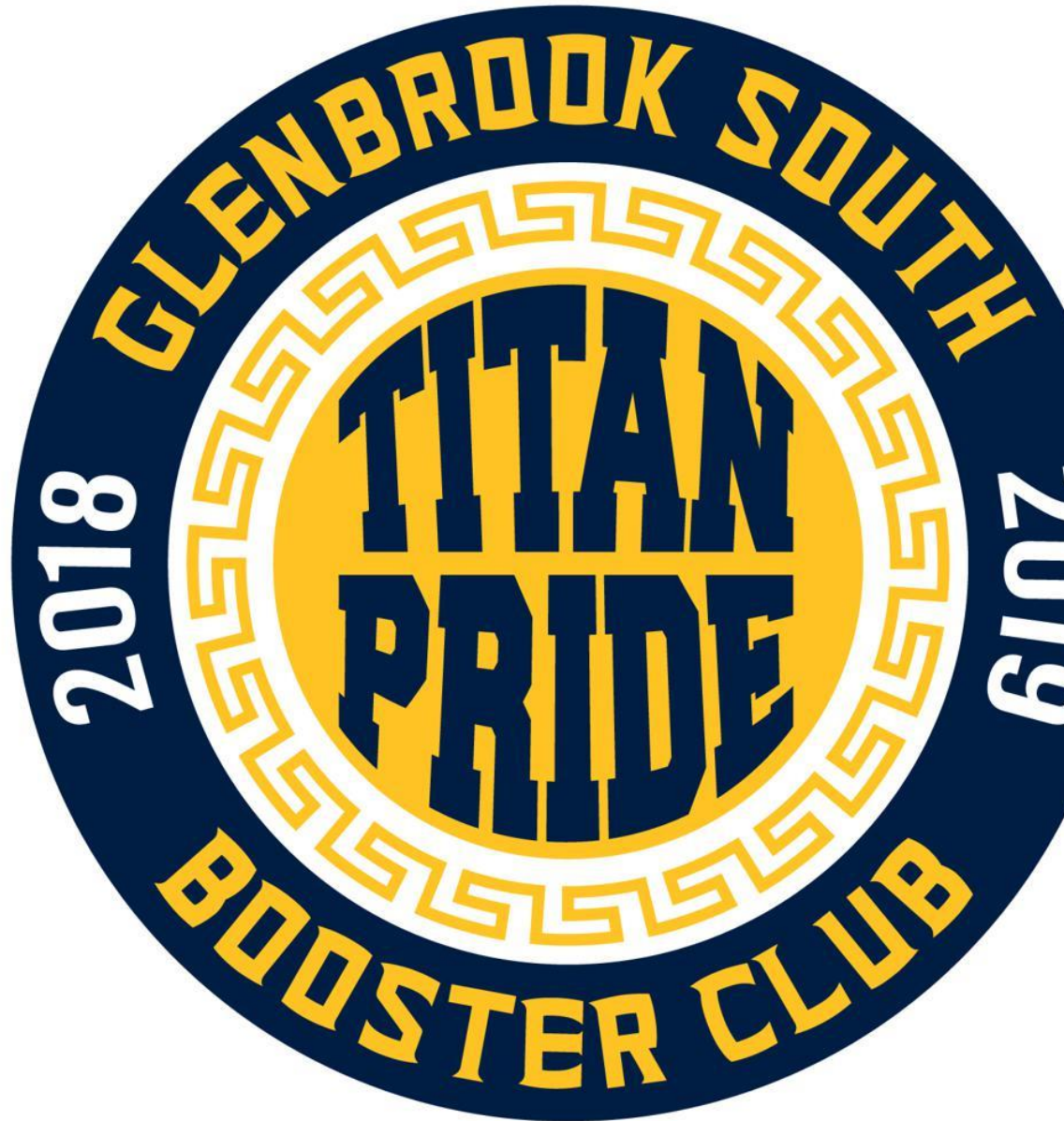

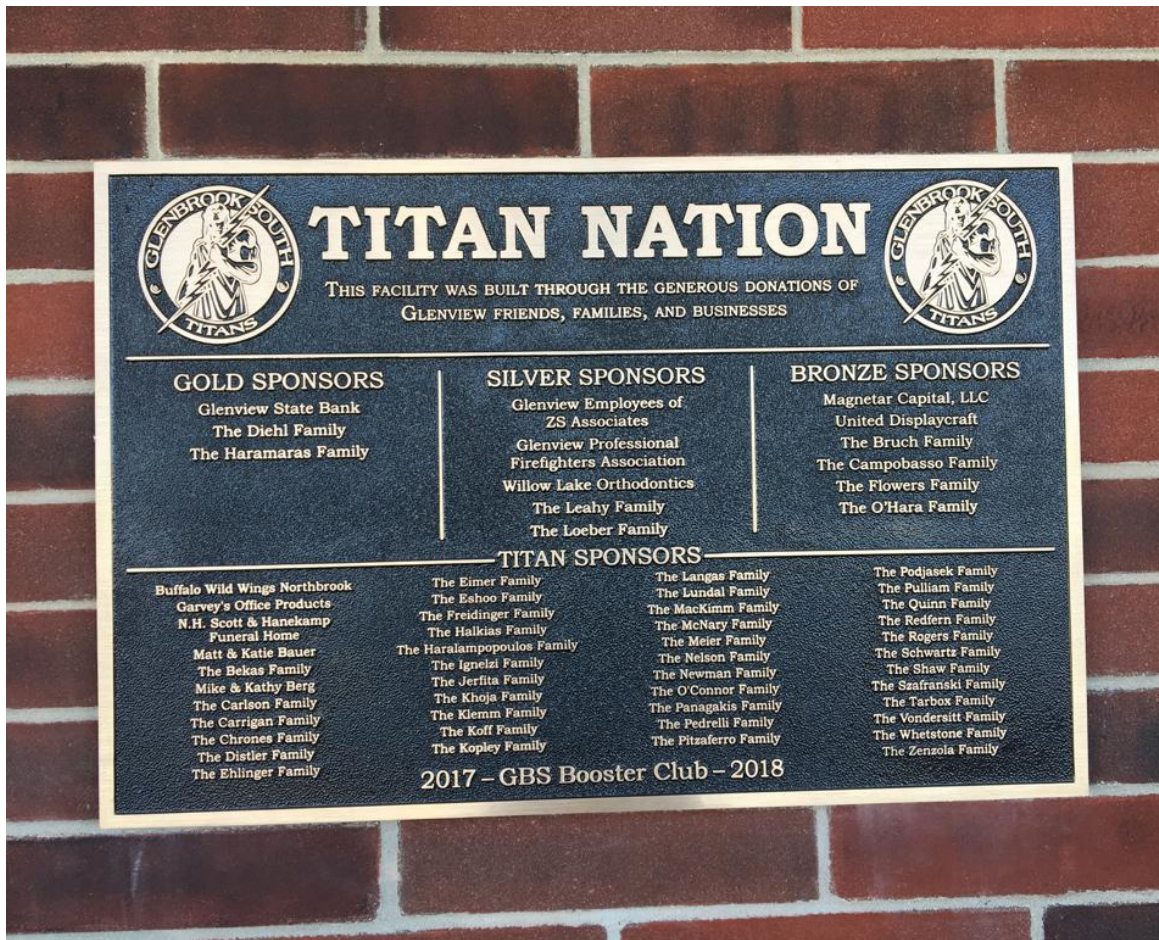
