

# All-Star Selection Process

Carlsbad Softball Association  
8U, 10U & 12U Divisions



## ALL-STAR INTENT FORM

1. Players who want to be eligible for an All-Star team are strongly encouraged to submit an online All-Star Intent form, but walk up tryouts will also be eligible.
2. A player may withdraw their All-Star intent up until the date of tryouts. If the player attends tryouts and then chooses to withdraw, that player will not be eligible the following All-Star season.
3. The All-Star Intent form requires the player to declare whether she has participated with a travel ball team and the last date of participation. USA Softball of Southern California defines "participation" as attending a tryout, practice, practice game, game, or tournament, regardless of whether the player actively played. **March 31** is the last day a player may participate with a travel team and still be eligible for All Stars.

## ALL-STAR TRYOUT RANKING

1. Attendance at the All-Star tryout is mandatory.
2. If a player cannot attend tryouts due to sickness or other urgent circumstance, a guardian must email the President or Players Agent to request a waiver prior to tryouts.
  - a. If a player is a daughter, granddaughter, or other relation of the All-Star manager, a waiver may only be requested for sickness or family emergency.
  - b. Waiver requests must be approved by a vote of the CSA Board of Directors. If the waiver is denied, the player will not be eligible for All Stars.
3. Division managers and outside evaluators will score the players on various skills demonstrated at the tryout using a point system in which a higher point value represents better performance. These evaluations will be submitted using the Tidepool Sports app.
4. For each player, managers scores for all skills will be summed to create a **Total Tryout Score**.
  - a. Players with approved waivers will receive a Total Tryout Score of 0.
5. Players will be ranked from highest Total Tryout Score to lowest to create a **Tryout Ranking** list.

## TRYOUT RANKING

1. The player's position on the Tryout Ranking list will be used to create a **Tryout Sum**. A higher score indicates a better player.
2. The players will be ranked from highest tryout sum to lowest to create a final **Ranking**. The overall Ranking is the basis for All Star selection.

## ALL-STAR DRAFT

1. The top 6 players as measured by the Tryout Ranking will be assigned to the Gold team. The Gold manager then completes their roster with picks from all remaining eligible players.
2. From the remaining eligible players, the next top 6 players will be assigned to the Silver team. The Silver manager then completes their roster with picks from all remaining eligible players.
3. The Gold and Silver managers have the option to veto one of the top 6 players from their team.
4. The Gold manager has 25 minutes to pick their final roster, and then the Silver manager has 25 minutes to pick their final roster. If time expires, the Players Agent will make picks to complete rosters.
5. The Players Agent must approve all manager selections and vetoes.
6. All-Star team rosters must be approved by the CSA Board of Directors per USA Softball of Southern California rules.
