on March 26, 2022. Shooting lines 9:00 a.m., 1:00 p.m., and 5:00 p.m.

JOAD U18 (Cadet) or U21 (Junior) \$30

Family maximum \$65

Format

Recurve/Barebow — One round of 60 arrows; 18 meters

- U21 and U18: 40 cm target face (choice of single-spot or vertical 3-spot face) — must use choice for entire tournament); outer 10-ring scoring
- U15 and U13: 60 cm target face; outer 10-ring scoring
- Collegiate and Adults: 40 cm target face (choice of single-spot or vertical 3-spot face) — must use choice for entire tournament); outer 10-ring scoring

Compound — One round of 60 arrows; 18 meters

- 40 cm target face (choice of single-spot or vertical 3-spot face) — must use choice for entire tournament); inner 10-ring scoring

Basic Compound — One round of 60 arrows; 18 meters

- U15 and U13 only: 60 cm target face; outer 10-ring scoring

Fixed Pins/Bowhunter (JOAD and Collegiate only) — One round of 60 arrows; 18 meters

- 40 cm target face (choice of single-spot or vertical 3-spot face) — must use choice for entire tournament); outer 10-ring scoring

Requirements

This is a Star FITA event. USA Archery members will be eligible to earn national or world records. Participants in the youth divisions for the JOAD State Indoor Championship must be members of a Minnesota JOAD club as well as a USA Archery member to compete for awards in this event. Other youth may participate as guests, but will not be eligible for awards.

Collegiate or adult archers in the State 18-Meter Championship must be USA Archery and MAA members to compete for awards. Current NFAA members may compete for awards by obtaining a free, [temporary USA Archery number](#). Others are welcome to participate as guests, but will not be eligible for awards. To register in the collegiate division, archers must be from an official USA Archery collegiate archery program.

A membership in the MAA is required for any archer's score to be eligible for a state record.

The maximum arrow diameter for this event is 9.3 mm. These arrows are commonly referred to as "23s" for their 23/64" diameter. Common examples of arrow shafts at or near the maximum diameter include Easton X23, Gold Tip Nine.3, Black Eagle PS23, and Victory V-TAC 23.

The USA Archery dress code will be enforced.
