

EHS Boys Basketball Booster Club Meeting Minutes
Monday, April 19, 2021
7 pm

Alissa opened the meeting at 7:05 pm, welcomed everyone, and kicked us off with a discussion about the April 24-25 MYAS tournament. Scott agreed to pick up extra masks, disinfectant wipes for cleaning between games, and the gym key. Alissa will order lanyards for the site managers and create a site manager binder with volunteer sign-in sheets and other pertinent information. Our MYAS contact was still getting back to Scott with several details - who owns updating the brackets and providing the wristbands, if we need to sort out t-shirts or awards for winning teams, and whose responsibility it is to collect scoresheets, provide clipboards and pencils. The custodian will be setting up chairs for Saturday morning. We agreed to leave the volunteer schedule as-is Saturday morning just in case there is extra work that we are not anticipating. Leading up to the tournament, the cancelling and re-scheduling of DIBS sessions has not been intuitive unfortunately, causing a lot of back and forth with volunteers. We will need to research this further for next time.

We will vote for board vacancies in May. Ideally, it would be great to have a parent from the incoming senior class. We will do some work between now and the May meeting on this.

Kevin shared updates on the summer BBQ, summer leagues, and 2021-2022 coaching:

- Save the Date! We will be having a family BBQ July 27th at Blackhawk Park Pavilion. More information to come.
- Summer team information and schedules will be coming out towards the end of April.
- Coach Pillow and Coach Roberts will not be returning in the fall. Kevin has found a 9B coach and is still looking for a 9A coach. Coach Knutson will be moving up and coaching the 10th grade team.

Scott gave the Treasurer's update. We have just under \$30,000 in the bank and expect additional funds from the tournament. We will need to order new uniforms in July, which is earlier than normal. We expect this to be approximately \$4,000 - \$5,000. Sandy wants to approve the uniforms. We will order practice jerseys for the incoming freshman later on, closer to the fall. Scott also led a discussion on summer league and tournament fees. Additional information has since come to light. More will be communicated at the May meeting.

Jess shared that Red's Savoy Pizza is willing to do another fundraiser night with us. The group voted on the Tuesday after Memorial Day. Jess will follow up with her contact and see if we can lock in this date. Jess also shared that we are still working to connect with Sandy about the Parent - Coach survey previously suggested.

The Raising Cane's fundraiser is this Thursday, April 22nd. The posters for the drive-thru are being delivered on Wednesday. Pam is working to have it advertised at school. Alissa will create social media posts.
