## Renters of Irish Dome

As we prepare for a new season at the dome, we share with you the following

- **IRISH SPORTS DOME GUEST POLICY**—When the Dome has multiple renters and/or mixed-use activities at the same time:

⇒ Signage will be displayed in the entrance on Wednesdays, and other days as needed

Coaches and Players **ONLY** - beyond this point  
Parents and Spectators **PROHIBITED** beyond this point

- **SCHEDULE**—If you would like a schedule of your rental dates, please request via an email at [sales@IrishDomeMN.com](mailto:sales@IrishDomeMN.com).

- **PARKING**

⇒ [Parking map](#) | Hope the parking map is helpful to those that are new to the dome, and a reminder to those that have played at the dome in the past.

⇒ **Parking in the north lot is by permit parking only.** Coaches can request a parking pass with staff at the front desk. Those without permit, may be towed. The first layer of enforcement starts with the renter. In your communication with your coaches/players/parents, let them know that they may be towed if a parking pass is not visible.

- **SOCCER**

⇒ When done using the goals, return goal(s) behind the netting, pushed back against the concrete base of the dome.

⇒ (4) 30x60 soccer fields will be lined weekly. If you need a full size field lined, please provide me your game schedule, a minimum of two weeks prior to first game

⇒ Goals with nets—Dome has (4) pair of 21'x7' and (1) pair of 24'x8'

- **BASEBALL & SOFTBALL**

⇒ Users are not allowed to throw or pitch using the dome safety netting as a backstop. Users are to work towards the center of the dome and provide their own portable back stops.

- **REALLOCATION OF FIELD SPACE**—There may be times when the field(s) that were originally scheduled for you have been switched. (ex, field 1 & 2 have been switched to field 3 & 4, OR batting cage 1 has been switched to batting cage 3). Check the board in the entrance of the dome that is updated daily with field allocation or connect with staff on duty.

- **START AND END TIME OF RENTAL**—Inform players, coaches, parents of the start and end time. Rentals are back to back, by not arriving to early or hanging out past rental time is appreciated by those before and after each rental.

## IRISH SPORTS DOME PARTICIPANT AND SPECTATOR RULES OF CONDUCT

Welcome to the Irish Sports Dome (ISD). In order for all participants and spectators to have a positive, quality experience and get the most out of their time here everyone expects the following rules to be enforced.

1. ISD has the right to suspend or ban any player, parent, coach, umpire or spectator from playing at or entering the facility. This decision is at the sole discretion of the facility manager but can also be based upon recommendations from other coaches, teachers, umpires or referees. Appeals must be submitted in writing or via email.
2. Inappropriate language or comments towards anyone by anyone is grounds for suspension for the offender.
3. Proper attire is expected of all participants and spectators. All participants must wear the customary sport-specific attire and safety equipment. Footwear must be reasonable for artificial turf, no metal spikes allowed.
4. All participants must sign a Player Waiver form before participating in any activity. Failure to do so will result in immediate suspension.
5. All spectators enter the facility at their own risk, the facility is designed for participants, not spectators, and extreme care must be taken by spectators to avoid accidental injury from balls, players etc.
6. ISD is not responsible for any lost or stolen item(s). Please do not bring any valuables into the dome. We maintain a lost and found so please ask if you are missing an item.
7. Warm-up areas are not provided unless you rent it, so please respect others and stay off of their space until it is your time.
8. All youth teams/participants must have a designated responsible parent or coach (over age 18) with them at all times. Participants must not take the field until this person is supervising their activity
9. You must exit your field with your equipment when your time expires. Do not start picking up your equipment when your time expires. If you interrupt the usage of another customer you may be charged a portion of their rental fee.
10. No littering INCLUDING SUNFLOWER SEED SHELLS. Teams/groups may be assessed a fine up to \$100.00 or suspended if littering is observed by the on-site manager.
11. No coolers. Seal able water bottles/drinks are allowed. No sunflower seeds. No chewing gum is allowed in the dome. No spitting. No tobacco or alcohol products of any nature are allowed in the dome or on the grounds.
12. Each team/rental group must provide their own First Aid kit.
13. We have the right to honor any other organization's judiciary sanctions against players, teams, and officials.
14. Please treat all referees and umpires respectfully. Each referee/umpire has complete authority and his/her decisions with any call in each game are final. Referees/umpires are independent subcontractors and are not employees of the Irish Sports Dome (ISD). ISD staff is interested in maintaining quality referees and umpires, and your written comments and concerns will be addressed.
15. Respect the dome itself. Do not kick soccer balls or throw any objects onto the walls of the dome, only into the appropriate nets. Failure to use the dome or any equipment in the dome properly will result in a suspension.



# GENERAL WAIVER

I|We understand that the Irish Dome provides no pre-enrollment medical examination and takes no responsibility for monitoring and assessing the health and physical condition of the participant.

IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE PARTICIPANT'S APPLICATION | REGISTRATION TO ENROLL IN THE IRISH DOME'S PROGRAM, AND WITH THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE ASSOCIATED RISK TO THE PARTICIPANT, I|WE AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING.

I|We consent to the participant enrolling in the Irish Dome's program, and participating in the events and activities which constitute the program.

I|We will instruct the participant to review and carefully follow all of the Irish Domes guidelines, rules and procedures of safety and general deportment while on the Irish Domes premises, whether or not the participant is engaged in training events or activities at the time.

I|We accept and assume full responsibility for consulting with a doctor about the training program required to participate in any event at Irish Dome, and hereby warrant, represent, and state that the participant named below is in good physical condition and that the participant has no disability, impairment, or ailment that would prevent him/her health, safety, comfort or physical condition. In the case of emergency, I|We grant permission for medical treatment to be given at a local hospital.

I|We accept and assume all risk and responsibility for accidents, illness, injury, death and/or damages, which may result from the Participant traveling to or from or participating in any of the events or activities at Irish Dome, and hereby waive, release and discharge the Irish Dome, its officers, directors, employees, and agents or anyone associated with the Irish Dome from any and all liability therefore
