Call to Order: Brooke McKenna called the meeting to order at 6:03pm, quorum established. Jeff requested a change to October meeting minutes. Will review and approve at December meeting.

Discussion

Executive Director - Frank Salvoni - Discussed a public comment that was placed in a recent edition of the Mtn. Express regarding girls programming in SVYH. Quick update on the shoulder check program. Several teams traveling to tournaments this weekend. Excited for a new year and teams are looking good. Goalie camps need more shooters. Brought up the need for locker room monitors to help out and assistant coaches to fill in as needed.

Registrar's Report – Nancy Fenn - Registration numbers are good (268) and only 10 below the anticipated number. The trial period ends this Friday so hopefully some of the learn-to-skate players will join as well. We had 3 players with season-ending injuries. Those families are checking if they purchased the registration insurance or not. Younger teams have large numbers this year and the tournament registrations so far look really strong. We have possible interest for the 6u and 8u home tournament so hopefully we can have one. Requested to seek a qualified person to take over SafeSport investigations. Currently working with the State SafeSport Coordinator which helps a lot, but it's becoming too much for Nancy to handle solo. Sarah mentioned the State is trying to get to a point where all SafeSport inquiries are sent directly to the state level and handled there instead of local. In the meantime we would like to find someone who can be the SafeSport Coordinator for SVYH. Wreaths went well this year and we sold \$5k more than last year plus a donation at the end. HS Boys Varsity had a 100% participation and 8u had almost everyone. Wreath captains did amazing and it went very well.

Hailey Ice – Sarah Benson - We have a women's tournament and girls jamboree next weekend. HS tournament after the holiday then Suns games start so the season is heating up. Val is going to have a weekend practice here. The Airport Inn is no longer a hotel and is being converted to long term housing. This will reduce the amount of rooms available for our local tournaments. It has been fun to have everyone back in the rink for the start of a new season. Thanks to Ryan and John for leading the Bauer learn-to-skate program which has gone very well.

Treasurer's Report – Barton Burdette We have the current report highlighted versus prior years performance. Largely thanks to Frank and his efforts we are looking good with donations and our revenue is ahead of last year also. Ice costs are the same as last year thanks to Sarah keeping the prices down for us as long as possible. Tuition continues to come in through January when the payment plans end. Discussed the bank accounts and savings for total current assets. Looking good.

President's Report– Brooke McKenna - Did everyone have a chance to review the recent 990 draft? It has been reviewed by the Finance Committee with minor changes to help clean up. Discussed the scholarship fund this year and who has applied. After a brief discussion, it was decided that we should have Ian Jameson come talk with the board about our investments and cash needs. The varsity team manager requested we revisit how the breezers approval process happened. All 3 high school teams will be ordering and wearing them.

Motion - Jeff made a motion to approve the 990 draft - John seconded, all approved.
