

## 2019-2020 Chancellor Hockey Organizational Meetings

### Parent Meeting Topics:

- Coach introductions
- Ice time – will not be equal during games and at the discretion of the coaching staff (and impacted by game situations such as penalties)
- Behaviour expectations of players
  - Cell phones – turn in before changing for game; pick up after game
  - Travel – transportation to away games is on team bus or by parent with prior notice
  - Smoking/vaping/drugs/drinking – no
  - School attendance is important
  - At rink 1h 45m before games; 45m before practices

  - Ask your player first – likely a conversation with coach(es) has happened already
  - PLEASE be confident that none of the adult volunteers working with the team would ever purposely take an action with the intention to insult or delay to development of your child – and we are human

# CHANCELLOR HOCKEY

## Team Rules

1. Players are required to attend all team functions – games, practices, meetings, etc. This includes if players are injured – you are still part of the team and are expected to attend. Players not able to attend team functions must contact Coach Trotz (Bench App) as far in advance as possible.
2. Players are required to arrive 1 hour 30 minutes before home games (we plan for the bus to arrive at arenas we visit approx. 1 hour 45 minutes before games). Players are required to travel to road games on the team bus, which leaves from Minnedosa. It is your responsibility to be at the bus on time. A player can return home with their parents only if your parent lets Mrs. Barrett know – last minute plan changes are NOT welcomed. At most rinks warmup is 30 minutes prior to game time.
3. Players are required to arrive at the arena 45 minutes before practice. Practices are on Tuesday @ 7:15-8:45 pm at the Minnedosa Arena.
4. Game Day dress code: Dress clothes (a shirt, tie, dress pants, shoes) to all games (home and away) and tournaments. No hats.
5. Cell phones at Games: players are required to turn in their cell phone before they enter the dressing room to put on hockey equipment. The team manager will keep the phones secure until they are returned on the bus (road games) or in the rink lobby (home games).
6. Players are expected to respect each other, opponents, refs, fans, arenas, and community at all times. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated – on or off the ice (both online or in person)
7. There will be absolutely no drinking, smoking, or drugs allowed.
8. Cell phones should not be used in the dressing room. You are there to get ready to practice/play hockey with your team so focus on being part of that experience rather than being on your phone.
9. If you are sick and unable to attend school – you do not play  
\*this is aimed at preventing players from trying to get better or rest during school so that you can play later but also includes general absenteeism\*

If you skip school – you do not play

If you miss a practice without reason – you do not play (you should phone/text coach before practice with reason)

Do not be late or miss school.

10. The team Bus and all Arenas are treated as part of the school when a games or practices are being played. All school rules for participation/behaviour on sports team are in effect. Team and school rules for everyone.
11. Curfew – 11:00 pm on pre-game nights
12. Playing high school hockey is a privilege not a right. Failure to abide by the above rules will result in a reduction of ice time, a player being benched, player not dressed for a game, or suspension from the team (in addition to any school or legal consequences).
13. Chancellor Hockey is a competitive, varsity high school sport. Not all players will be given equal playing time. These decisions will be made by the Coaches.

When you are playing high school hockey you will be treated fairly and with respect. Your coaches and managers expect the same – this extends bus drivers and arena staff. You are required to give your best effort when practicing and playing. Your year will be competitive, and we will try to create and maintain a positive atmosphere both in the dressing room and on the ice. Our purpose is to have fun, and learn some hockey skills (and also some life skills).

### Dealing with complaints:

Please follow a 24 hour rule before bringing a complaint forward to your Coach. We will ask your parents/guardians to do the same when addressing issues with the team Manager.
