



2021 PUGET SOUND REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS & BID TOURNAMNET

Club directors and coaches are responsible for the implementation of all safety procedures.

1) TEAM CHECK-IN:

- a) Club Directors must input their playing roster in **SE MMS** no later than Wednesday prior to the event.
- b) Rosters will be on-site and the coach will verify roster at check-in.
- c) We will be allowing a limited number of spectators, in compliance with the current phase mandates. Please have coach check in for the team and turn in the signed waiver form. Each team can have **up to 6 spectators on their waiver form (U12-U17) and ONE spectator per rostered athlete for U18s ONLY**. The coach will be issued wristbands when they turn in the waiver form. **No waiver form, no entry.**
- d) Teams must check out at end of Day 1 play. The waiver form for Day 2 needs to be presented at check-in on Day 2 in order to receive wrist bands for Day 2.
- e) **EARLY BIRD CHECK-IN will be available on Friday night (7:00pm to 8:30pm)**
- f) Please refer to the playing schedule on AES so you are aware which gym you will be playing in.

2) SITE ENTRY

- a) Teams may enter the facility no more than 45 minutes prior to the first whistle.
- b) Teams will enter through the front of the building under the tent and follow colored arrows to their designated gym entrance.
- c) Staggered entry: If your team does not play the first round, team entry will be no more than 45 minutes prior to first assignment.
- d) Spectators can enter no more than 10 minutes before the start of play for their wave.
- e) Coaches will be required to verify the team's roster at check in. **ALL** rostered coaches will be required to present their ID at this time.
- f) The coaches meeting will take place 30 minutes before the start of play.

3) FACILITY INFORMATION

- a) Masks are required by everyone at all times.
- b) Facility is under construction, absolutely no one is permitted in construction areas.
- c) Bleacher seating WILL BE provided.
- d) Spectators are asked to maintain social distancing. We ask that there be at least 6' distance between spectators. Our staff is mainly concerned with managing the tournament and maintaining a safe and clean playing environment – not making sure spectators keep their distance or follow rules. There will be zero tolerance for spectators that either do not wear a mask or do not practice social distancing. **They will simply be asked give up their wristbands and leave.**
- e) Please adhere to signage. There is a map posted on the tournament page with areas for spectators and team areas. Spectators are restricted to spectator areas and are not permitted in the playing areas or the team areas,
- f) **Absolutely no outside food or drink is allowed in the facility.**
- g) Personal water bottles are permitted. There are water bottle filling stations in the facility.
- h) There will not be a trainer on-site. Ice and first-aid supplies will be available, if needed.
- i) Teams may not socialize with other teams.
- j) Teams will be required to return to their team area or depart the facility when not competing.
- k) Teams and spectators are to exit the through the double doors at the back of the building on court level when finished.
- l) Spectators should give up their space when their teams are not competing.
- m) Hand sanitizer stations are located throughout the facility.

4) EVENT PROCEDURES

- a) See AES for specific pool & play information online. We will not be posting any paper scores or results on the wall. Everything will be on AES.



- b) All matches will be 2/3 to 25/25/15 (no cap). Please be sure you know your schedule (this is also on AES).
- c) The following items and areas will be sanitized between matches. Please allow staff to clean these areas before taking the court for warm-up.
 - i) Game ball(s)
 - ii) Officials stand and padding
 - iii) Top and bottom of the net tape, standards, and padding
 - iv) Score table, chairs, clipboard, flip chart, pencils/pens
 - v) Team benches (if provided by site)
- d) All warm-ups will be 2-4-4. Officiating teams are required to start immediately after the court has been cleaned.
- e) After the first round of play start times are an estimate. Subsequent matches will begin after the court area has been sanitized.
- f) Teams should not approach the team bench area until the area has been cleared and sanitized.
- g) Teams that play back-to-back matches on their court do not need to leave their bench area for cleaning.
- h) Teams that officiate after their match DO need to clear the bench area and allow the scorekeeper area to be cleaned before they “move in”.
- i) Teams will not shag balls for their opponent during warm-ups.
- j) The coin flip will be performed with one captain per team, 6 feet from the scorer’s table.
- k) Teams will not switch benches between sets.
- l) Players should not touch during substitutions.
- m) The pre-game and post-game “handshake” will be done from the 3-meter line.
- n) Remove all items from bench area before leaving the court.
- o) Leave team area clean and throw away all trash.
- p) Teams must check out end-of-day with site directory prior to leaving the facility. Coaches can pick up their Sunday wristbands before leaving on Saturday. They will be issued the number of wristbands that match their Sunday waiver form.

5) OFFICIATING

- a) An R1 will be provided for each match
- b) **Teams will be required to use the official USAV scoresheet for this event**
- c) **Electronic whistles are required (each team will bring own whistle).**
- d) (U14 and younger) The team designated to referee will provide the following:
 - i) A rostered adult coach to serve as an R2
 - ii) Two lines people
 - iii) At least 2, but no more than 3 additional players/coaches to serve as a scorekeeper, libero tracker and scoreboard flipper/operator.
- e) (U15 and older) The team designated to referee will provide the following:
 - i) A certified R2
 - ii) If the R2 is a player, a coach must be court-side
 - iii) Two lines people
 - iv) At least 2, but no more than 3 additional players/coaches to serve as a scorekeeper, libero tracker and scoreboard flipper/operator.
